Provides for the transference, operation, and management of certain schools into the recovery district, to expand the authority of the recovery district, and to provide for the duration of the transfer. (gov sig)

- SB52 Murray ATTORNEY GENERAL  
Provides for the attorney general to issue cease and desist orders during a state of emergency or disaster. (gov sig)  
- Read by title, under the rules, referred to the Committee on Judiciary.
- SB68 Chaisson CRIME/PUNISHMENT  
Provides for the crime of conducting business without a proper license or permit. (gov sig)  
- Reported with amendments (9-0) (Regular). Referred to the Legislative Bureau.  
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments.
- SB71 Dupre COASTAL RESOURCES  
Authorizes development and implementation of a comprehensive coastal protection plan. (gov sig)  
- Called from the calendar.  
- Read by title, amended and designated duplicate of HB 141.  
- Referred to the Legislative Bureau.  
- Reported with Legislative Bureau amendments.
- SB89 Jones VOTERS/VOTING  
Provides for holding elections impaired as a result of a gubernatorially declared disaster or emergency pursuant to a plan for registration, early voting, absentee voting by mail, and election day voting. (gov sig)  
- Read by title, under the rules, referred to the Committee on House and Governmental Affairs.
- SCR8 Adley MINERALS  
Memorializes Congress to extend Louisiana's seaward boundary in the Gulf of Mexico to twelve geographical miles.  
- Reported favorably (8-0).  
- Rules suspended. Read by title, passed to 3rd reading.
- SCR16 Shepherd UTILITIES  
Requests the various public utilities throughout the state delay the collection of residential user fees for the month of December, 2005, for those individuals in certain hurricane affected areas of the state.  
- Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Commerce.
- SCR18 Shepherd SECRETARY OF STATE  
Directs the secretary of state to establish a toll-free telephone line for displaced citizens to advise them of voting locations and to advertise nationally seeking displaced Louisiana voters.
