SB55 Adley INSURERS

SB89 Jones VOTERS/VOTING

SB95 Boasso LEVEES

Reorganizes certain levee boards and creates and provides for the Southeast Louisiana Levee Authority. (gov sig)

SB96 Shepherd TAX/SALES

Provides that the state sales or use tax shall not apply to consumer purchases of tangible personal property for non-business use of \$25,000 or less between 3:00 P.M. Tuesday, December 6, 2005, and midnight Sunday, December 11, 2005. (gov sig)

SB102 Fields TAX/TAXATION

Removes the exemption from the hotel occupancy tax in certain parishes for rooms rented for 30 or more days. (gov sig)

SB105 Hines FUNDS/FUNDING

Provides relative to the balance in the Budget Stabilization Fund. (1/1/06)

Provides relative to licensure of health care providers, provider agreements, and the provisions of the facility need review process.

SCR9 Uilo SCHOOLS
