Creates the Louisiana Habitat for Humanity Loan Purchase Program within the Louisiana Housing Finance Agency. (1/1/06)

- SB94 Gautreaux, N. CONSUMERS/PROTECTION
Provides protections from utility payments for consumers whose property is damaged in an area declared a state of emergency or disaster. (gov sig)

- SB95 Boasso LEVEES
Reorganizes certain levee boards and creates and provides for the Southeast Louisiana Levee Authority. (gov sig)

- SCR9 Ullio SCHOOLS
Suspends certain provisions governing the operation of and formation of charter schools.

- SCR12 Heitmeier FUNDS/FUNDING
Authorizes incorporation of certain monies from the Budget Stabilization Fund into the official forecast for FY 2005-2006. (2/3 - CA7s10.3(C)(2))
- Read by title, adopted by the vote of 36 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.
- SCR15 Ullio FUNDS/FUNDING
Approves adjustments adopted by BESE on 11/9/2005 to the MFP formula for FY 2005-06 approved by the Legislature as SCR 125 of the 2005 R.S.
- Read by title, adopted by the vote of 33 yeas and 2 nays and ordered to the House.

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- SCR20 Gautreaux, N. CONSUMERS/PROTECTION
Requests the Louisiana Public Service Commission to promulgate rules and regulations to protect consumers whose water or gas service ran unabated in an area declared to be a state of disaster or emergency.
