- SB3 Schedler FISCAL CONTROLS
Provides for an extension of time to various governmental entities relative to the preparation of certain financial documents in the event of a disaster or emergency as declared by the governor. (gov sig)
- Read by title and finally passed as amended 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB4 Schedler FISCAL CONTROLS
Provides for an extension of time for governmental entities to prepare certain financial documents during the process of obtaining approval to incur debt related to a gubernatorial declared disaster or emergency. (gov sig)
- Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call
- Read by title and finally passed as amended 37 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB6 Jones VOTERS/VOTING
Authorizes a person who has registered by mail, not voted since, and been displaced by a gubernatorially declared emergency to vote absentee by mail and provides for a parish board of election supervisors to use commissioners from another parish. (gov sig)

- SB15 Cain ETHICS
Requires state elected and appointed officials and members of their immediate family to report income received from the federal government as a result of services performed or products sold for disaster recovery.

- SB18 Mount TAX EXEMPTIONS
Constitutional amendment to authorize retention of the homestead exemption and the special assessment level at its pre-disaster level if the homestead is unoccupied because of damage or destruction by a disaster or emergency if the repaired or rebuilt homestead is reoccupied within five years.
- Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call

- SB19 Mount TAX/AD VALOREM
Authorizes extensions or suspends various deadlines for 2005 taxes and makes technical changes to present law by changing specified dates to time limits expressed in number of days. (gov sig)

- SB20 Mount TAX/AD VALOREM
Provides for the extension of the homestead exemption and the "special assessment level" in the event of a public disaster, and a procedure for the postponement of payments of property taxes in the event of public disaster. (gov sig)

- SB42 Mount TAX/TAXATION
Prevents an increase in Louisiana income tax because of a reduction in federal income taxes as a result of (1) a federal credit if the secretary determines that the credit is a hurricane disaster relief credit granted, or (2) a casualty loss incurred as a result of the hurricanes. (gov sig)

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- SB103 QUINN TAX/AD VALOREM
Changes assessment and collection procedures for property damaged or destroyed by disaster or emergency declared by the governor.
- Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB104 Schedler TAX/AD VALOREM
Changes assessment and collection procedures for property damaged or destroyed by disaster or emergency declared by the governor.
- Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB105 Hines FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides relative to the balance in the Budget Stabilization Fund. (gov sig)
- Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate. Rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Finance.
- SB106 Fields COURTS
Provides for procedures for the continuation of the criminal justice system for the 19th JDC. (gov sig)
- Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate. Rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary B.
- SB107 McPherson HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT
Provides relative to licensure of health care providers, provider agreements, and the provisions of the facility need review process.
- Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate. Rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Health and Welfare.
- SB108 Hines FUNDS/FUNDING
Authorizes appropriation of additional amounts from the Budget Stabilization Fund after declaration of a disaster or emergency.

- SB109 Gautreaux, N. COASTAL RESOURCES
Requires the wetlands authority to implement an inspection program for coastal and hurricane protection.

- SB110 Michot LAND USE
Authorizes the wetlands authority to develop an intracoastal protection highway.
- Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate, read first time by title.
- SCR5 Jones PARISHES
Urges the governor to include East Carroll Parish as a community in the Northern Louisiana Renewal Community.
- Enrolled and signed by the President of the Senate.
- SCR11 Smith, Mike COMMUNITY TECH SYSTEM
Requests that the governor expedite appointments to the Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges.
- Enrolled and signed by the President of the Senate.
- SCR12 Heitmeier FUNDS/FUNDING
Authorizes incorporation of certain monies from the Budget Stabilization Fund into the official forecast

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of 36 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.

Commends The Shreveport Sun on being the oldest black weekly newspaper in Louisiana.
- Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate. Read by title, rules suspended, adopted.
- HB3 Toomy RECORDS/RECORDATION
Changes the effective date of Act 169 of the 2005 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana (Item #67)
- Rules suspended; reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB11 Smiley MTR VEHICLE/REGISTRATION
Provides for disposal of water-damaged vehicles (Item #13)
- Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs.
- HB15 Cazayoux TRANSPORTATION DEPT
Provides relative to the contents of the petition to expropriate property for a design-build project undertaken by the Department of Transportation and Development (Item #47)
- Rules suspended; reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB18 Hutter RETIREMENT BENEFITS
Provides for public employees on involuntary furlough or leave without pay due to a disaster to continue to earn service credit in their retirement systems by making employee and employer contributions (Item #65)
- Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on Retirement.
- HB19 Crane EDUCATION/PRE-K
Provides for the applicability of provisions relative to the requirements for student/lead teacher and student/adult staff member ratios for LA 4 classes (Item #38)
- Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB20 Crane SCHOOLS/BOARDS
Provides for the applicability of provisions relative to the required dates for school boards to adopt budgets and submit such budgets to the state superintendent of education (Item #38)
- Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB21 Crane SCHOOLS
Provides for applicability of provisions relative to the requirement for a minimum school session of not less than 180 days for certain purposes (Item #38)

- HB22 Crane STUDENTS
Provides for applicability of provisions relative to the requirement for testing the sight and hearing of pupils within 30 days after the admission of any pupils entering school late in the session (Item #38)

- HB27 Salter ELECTIONS/SPECIAL
Provides for a special statewide election for the purpose of submitting constitutional amendments to the electors of the state (Item #4)

- HB28 Martiny LAW ENFORCEMENT
Limits liability of law enforcement agencies to prison detainees (Item #69)

- HB33 Crane SCHOOLS
Provides for applicability of provisions relative to minimum requirements for instructional time including certain work days per school year under specified circumstances (Item #38)
- Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB34 Alario TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION
(Constitutional Amendment) Provides for continuation of homestead exemption and special assessment level for property damaged or destroyed by natural disaster (Item #41)

- HB35 Arnold TAX/AD VALOREM TAX
Provides for a change of the time and date when the assessor of Orleans Parish has to complete the work on preparing and making up the assessment lists for the year 2006 (Item #42)

- HB44 Hammett TAX/AD VALOREM TAX
Provides with respect to the deferment of tax payments where property subject to ad valorem taxation has been damaged during a gubernatorially declared disaster or emergency (Item #40)
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB45 Hammett TAX
Provides for the furnishing of tax information to the taxpayer or his duly authorized representative (Item #49)
- Rules suspended; reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB46 Hammett TAX EXEMPTIONS/HOMESTEAD
Provides for the continuation of the homestead exemption and special assessments when property is damaged due to a gubernatorially declared disaster or emergency (Item #41)
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB56 Pinac GAMBLING
Provides with respect to slot machine purse supplements during force majeure
- Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB65 Hammett TAX/AD VALOREM TAX
Changes procedure for review of assessment lists and payment of ad valorem taxes for 2005 tax year and for 2006 tax year in Orleans Parish (Item #40)
- Rules suspended; reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB73 Martiny CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE
Provides criminal procedures for administration of criminal justice in times of emergency or disaster (Item #71)
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB78 Martiny GAMBLING

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Provides for definition of eligible facility during force majeure

- Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

HB84 Alario ADMINISTRATION DIVISION

Provides with respect to deadlines and requirements for the state's FY 2004-2005 comprehensive annual financial and narrative reports (Item #22)

- Read by title and finally passed, 34 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.

HB90 Ansardi PRESCRIPTION

Provides for the suspension of prescription

- Rules suspended, reported with amendments. Rules suspended, committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

HB92 Greene DIVORCE

Provides relative to the effect of suspension of legal deadlines on judgments of divorce

- Rules suspended; reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

HB93 Scalise SCHOOLS/DISTRICTS

Provides an additional means by which public schools may be transferred to the state's Recovery School District and prohibits certain persons from serving on Type 5 Recovery District Charter school governing authorities (Item #8)

HB94 Alario BUDGETARY PROCEDURES

Provides with respect to deadlines and requirements for the FY 2006-2007 budget (Item #24)

- Read by title and finally passed, 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.

HB95 Alario ADMINISTRATION

Suspends requirement for preparation of annual undersecretary's report for FY 2004-2005 (Item #23)

- Read by title and finally passed, 36 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.

HB96 Alario BUDGETARY PROCEDURES

Suspends the requirement for preparation of the continuation budget for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 (Item #25)

- Read by title and finally passed, 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.

HB97 Alario INSURANCE/GROUP-STATE

Provides for certain benefits offered through the Office of Group Benefits programs for employees who were furloughed or terminated as a result of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita (Item #20)

- Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on Insurance.

HB104 Greene CHILDREN/SUPPORT

Provides emergency legislation relative to child support

- Rules suspended; reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

HB121 Crane SCHOOLS

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Provides for the transfer, operation, and management of certain schools into the Recovery School District, expands the authority of the recovery district, and provides for the duration of the transfer (Item #8)

- Received in the Senate. Read by title.

HB127 Martiny CORRECTIONS/MEDICAL CARE

Provides for costs of medical care for prisoners

- Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

HB131 Salter FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS

Provides relative to the effective date of the Healthcare Affordability Act (Item #18)

- Designated a duplicate of SB No. 84.

- Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

HB132 Quezaire TRANSPORTATION DEPT

Authorizes the Department of Transportation and Development to utilize the design-build method for certain transportation projects

- Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

HB142 Salter STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP

Provides relative to TOPS continuing eligibility requirements for the 2005-06 academic year for postsecondary students displaced during such academic year as a consequence of Hurricane Katrina or Rita, or both (Item #37)

- Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

HB143 Salter STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP

Provides relative to initial eligibility requirements for TOPS awards for high school students displaced during the 2005-2006 school year as a consequence of Hurricane Katrina or Rita, or both (Item #37)

- Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

HCR26 Pinac RACING/HORSE

Suspends the provision of law requiring minimum number of live racing days

- Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

HCR45 Crowe CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION

Encourages the state attorney general and state treasurer to request records or other appropriate documentation from charities relative to any monetary donations collected on behalf of the state's hurricane victims
