- SB30 Adley TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Exempts \$12,000 of annual income of both the husband and wife if both are 65 years of age or older and filing a joint return. (gov sig)
- Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call
- SB39 Theunissen LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Provides for the membership and powers of the La. Commission on Civic Education. (gov sig)
- Read by title and finally passed as amended 33 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB44 Lentini ADMINISTRATION DIVISION
Requires the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget to approve certain vehicle purchases for use by any statewide elected official. (7/1/05)
- Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB45 Dupre PARISHES
Includes Terrebonne Parish assessor within the definition of "equivalent" officer for the purposes of certain actions by parishes and municipalities relative to liens for removal and securing of dangerous structures. (gov sig)
- Read by title and finally passed, 34 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB51 Cheek LOCAL EMPLOYEES
Provides with respect to financial security for surviving spouses or parents of firemen and law enforcement officers.
- Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB53 Fields ELECTION CODE
Provides for a closed party primary election system for congressional offices with candidates and voters participating in a first and second primary according to party affiliation. (1/1/06)

SB218 Dupre PUBLIC PROPERTY

Provides for the acquisition of surplus computer equipment by certain public educational institutions. (gov sig)

SB219 Fontenot FUNDS/FUNDING

Repeals the authority of PSC to establish rules for the Energy Efficiency Fund.

SB222 Hollis BANKS/BANKING

Authorizes imposition of an additional charge in a consumer credit transaction if the consumer makes an electronic payment.

- Reported favorably.

SB224 Hollis WILDLIFE/FISHERIES DEPT

Authorizes a system of special certificate agents to collect motorboat or sailboat registration certificate fees and issue registration certificates and decals, and to collect commercial fisherman's license fees and issue commercial fisherman's licenses. (gov sig) (2/3-CA7s2.1(A))

SB226 Gautreaux, N. CRIME/PUNISHMENT
