Extends for a period of three years the authorization for special permits for trucks hauling containerized cargo in international trade intended for export within a 50-mile radius of the Port of Ouachita. (gov sig)

- SB80 Murray PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Increases from \$15,000 to \$20,000 the contract amount of materials and supplies contracts with the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans that must be advertised for public bid. (gov sig)

- SB81 Murray LOCAL AGENCIES
Provides relative to conforming existing and future New Orleans Sewerage and Water Board facilities incidental to the operation of the sewer, water and drainage systems. (gov sig)
- Read by title and finally passed, 33 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB93 Nevers HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE
Provides for bidders on construction contracts who furnish health insurance coverage to their employees.
- Rules suspended; reported with amendments.
- SB97 Cravins MUNICIPALITIES
Provides with respect to municipal annexations in St. Landry Parish. (gov sig)
- Read by title and finally passed, 33 yeas and 1 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB99 Cravins SHERIFFS
Provides with respect to the payment of insurance premiums for retired sheriffs and deputy sheriffs in St. Landry Parish. (gov sig)
- Read by title and finally passed, 34 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB100 Cravins STUDENTS
Provides for an extension of time to claim educational benefits for members of the La. National Guard who are on inactive ready reserve status.
- Called from the calendar.
- Read by title and finally passed as amended 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB101 Boasso PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS
Provides for the membership of the board of commissioners of the St. Bernard Port, Harbor and Terminal District. (gov sig) (2/3-CA6s43(3))
- Read by title and finally passed as amended 33 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill

- SB186 Boasso CAMPAIGN FINANCE
Prohibits any elected official from receiving campaign contributions from any entity doing business with any state or statewide retirement systems.
 - Rules suspended; reported favorably.
- SB187 Dupre COASTAL RESOURCES
Constitutional amendment to provide that certain federal revenues received by the state generated from Outer Continental Shelf oil and gas activity shall be credited to the Wetlands Conservation and Restoration Fund and used only for certain purposes. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

- SB189 Broome HEALTH SERVICES
Provides for disclosure by those who provide information or recommend food, dietary supplements and homeopathic remedies.
 - Read by title and finally passed as amended 33 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB190 Broome HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT
Revises the law concerning citizens with developmental disabilities. (gov sig)
 - Read by title and finally passed as amended 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB195 Dupre COASTAL RESOURCES
Provides for deposit into Wetlands Conservation and Restoration Fund and uses of certain federal revenues generated from Outer Continental Shelf oil and gas activity.

- SB205 Duplessis DATA BASE
Provides for the Database Security Breach Notification Law. (1/1/06)
 - Read by title and finally passed as amended 33 yeas and 1 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB210 Heitmeier PUBLIC LANDS
Provides a procedure for filing claims for the return of certain lands in the Bohemia Spillway and for the payment of certain revenues derived from such property. (gov sig)
 - Read by title and finally passed, 34 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB212 Marionneaux CIVIL PROCEDURE
Requires a filing fee to be paid by the party praying for a jury in a civil trial.
 - Read by title and finally passed as amended 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB219 Fontenet FUNDS/FUNDING
Repeals the authority of PSC to establish rules for the Energy Efficiency Fund.
 - Read by title and finally passed, 28 yeas and 6 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB222 Hollis BANKS/BANKING
Authorizes imposition of an additional charge in a consumer credit transaction if the consumer makes

SB223 Hollis PHYSICIANS
Allows a professional medical corporation to include the practice of podiatry.

SB245 Schedler HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT
Provides for licensing of and a moratorium on facilities known as pain management clinics.

- Read by title and finally passed as amended 34 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.

SB258 Kostelka SUITS AGAINST STATE
Provides relative to the limitation of liability or damages under the Louisiana Governmental Claims Act. (gov sig)

- Read by title and finally passed as amended 31 yeas and 4 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.

SB268 Smith, Mike ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Provides, relative to the logo signing program, for contracts with qualified third parties to be a competitive process awarded pursuant to the procurement code. (gov sig)

SB271 McPherson HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT
