HB115	Gallot	CLERKS OF COURT	Prohibits the use of privately owned copying equipment within the clerk's office - Received in the Senate. Read by title.
HB158	Marchand	EDUCATION	Relative to compulsory K-12 school attendance, authorizes La. licensed nurse practitioners to substantiate certain illnesses permitting temporary absence and removes exemptions based on child's

HB178 Hutter SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES  
Prohibits, except under certain circumstances, public school boards and nonpublic schools and school systems from hiring specified persons convicted of certain crimes

HB184 Frith PROPERTY/PUBLIC  
Provides for the transfer of certain sixteenth section land in Vermilion Parish

- Received in the Senate. Read by title.

HB194 Faucheux TAX/LOCAL  
Authorizes sheriff to retain attorney at an hourly rate for tax and fee collection

- Reported with amendments.

HB197 Dove COASTAL RES/COASTAL ZONE  
Creates the Coastal Passes Stabilization and Restoration Program and Fund

- Received in the Senate. Read by title.

HB204 Cazayoux WATERWAYS/LAKES  
Exempts from royalty payments the dredging of False River to remove sediment or to enhance recreation and navigation

- Received in the Senate. Read by title.

HB209 Damico REAL ESTATE/COMMISSION  
Provides for selection of members to real estate commission and adds cause for discipline by commission

HB226 Gallot CIVIL/PROCEDURE  
Provides for the continuous revision of the Code of Civil Procedure

- Reported with amendments.

HB241 Downs TAX/HOTEL OCCUPANCY  
Changes the name of the Lincoln Parish tourist commission and authorizes an increase in the hotel occupancy tax

- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.

HB249 Frith PLANNING/ZONING  
Authorizes the Cameron Parish governing authority to provide for the siting of facilities for disposal, incineration, or storage of solid or liquid waste in the parish and provides relative to regulation of such waste in the parish

- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.

HB253 Burns PARKS  
Authorizes the Mandeville City Council to name the park behind Mandeville City Hall in honor of Paul D. Cordes

- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.

HB255 Ansardi RETIREMENT/LOCAL  
Repeals provisions of law relative to the Firemen's Pension and Relief Fund for the city of Kenner

- HB302 Wooton PROPERTY/PUBLIC  
Provides for the transfer of certain state property in Plaquemines Parish to the governing authority of the parish  
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB314 Walsworth PUBLIC BLDGS/GROUNDS-ST  
Authorizes the Ouachita Parish School Board to name the ROTC building at West Monroe High School in honor of James Donald Halsell, Jr.  
- Received in the Senate. Read by title.
- HB318 Badon SEIZURES/SALES  
Provides for notice of seizure to occupants of seized property  
- Reported with amendments.
- HB319 Morrish INSURANCE/PROPERTY  
Provides for the calculation of insurance rates under the Louisiana Citizens Property Insurance Corporation  
- Received in the Senate. Read by title.
- HB330 Hunter CRIMINAL/HABIT OFFENDERS  
Provides with respect to the habitual offender law  
- Received in the Senate. Read by title.
- HB331 Hill HUNTING/ALLIGATORS  
Provides relative to membership on the Louisiana Fur and Alligator Advisory Council  
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB336 Waddell ELECTION CODE  
Relative to voting in person, allows qualified voters to vote during a certain time period prior to the day of election and expands hours for such voting  
- Received in the Senate. Read by title.

- Reported favorably.
- HB344 McVea PROPERTY  
Provides relative to the exchange of certain state property in West Feliciana Parish

- HB351 Triche ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE PERMT  
Provides that a duplicate driver's license shall be lawful identification for purposes of purchasing alcoholic beverages

Removes the exemption of hepatitis C and antipsychotic drugs from the Louisiana prior authorization process with preferred drug list

- HB374 Bruce ETHICS/CODE  
Provides an exception to the post-service restrictions in the ethics code to allow a former member of the board of commissioners of DeSoto Parish Waterworks District No. 1 to be employed by the board  
- Received in the Senate. Read by title.
- HB377 Downs TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL  
Authorizes the Union Parish School Board, subject to voter approval, to levy and collect an additional sales tax  
- Received in the Senate. Read by title.
- HB385 Wooton FISHING/OYSTERS  
Provides relative to requirements for use of a commercial fishing vessel to harvest oysters  
- Received in the Senate. Read by title.
- HB397 Baldone FISHING/NETS  
Removes certain restrictions on unattended nets  
- Received in the Senate. Read by title.
- HB398 Hill MUNICIPALITIES  
Provides with respect to the period of time after which certain ordinances cannot be contested  
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB428 Pierre ENERGY/ALTERNATE  
Authorizes the Department of Natural Resources to lease state lands for the development or production of wind energy
