| | Allows registered voters temporarily displaced by a gubernatorially declared state of emergency who have registered by mail to vote absentee by mail without first voting in person at the polls or appearing or voting at the registrar's office (Item #19) | |

| | Creates the Louisiana Recovery Authority (Item #3) | |

| HB71 | Alario | CAPITAL OUTLAY |

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Provides for supplemental capital outlay appropriation for the 2005-2006 Fiscal Year to the Department of Military Affairs (Item #24)

- Reported with amendments (12-0) (Regular).
- Rules suspended; read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.

HB78 Montgomery PUBLIC CONTRACTS

Authorizes the adjutant general and the Military Department to utilize the design-build method for certain construction projects (Item #23)

- Reported with amendments (16-0) (Regular).
- Rules suspended; read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.

HB79 Hebert LEVEES/BDS & DISTRICTS

Provides relative to the terms of levee district commissioners (Item #1)

- Involuntarily deferred in committee.

HB87 Richmond COURTS

Establishes a Juvenile and Family Court of Orleans Parish and abolishes the jurisdiction of the Civil District Court for the parish of Orleans over domestic relations cases

- Read by title, returned to the calendar.

HB92 Hebert LOCAL GOVERNMENT

Authorizes any local governmental subdivision to create, within its governmental structure, an agency to regulate the location of certain temporary housing sites (Item #14)

- Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs.

HB93 Hammett BONDS

Authorizes state to issue bonds to provide relief from Hurricanes Katrina and Rita and implement certain bond provisions of the Gulf Opportunity Zone Act of 2005 (Item #33)

- Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

HB94 Tucker LEVEES/BDS & DISTRICTS

Reorganizes certain levee boards and creates and provides for the Southeast Louisiana Levee Authority (Item #1)

- Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works.

HB95 Morrell LEVEES/BDS & DISTRICTS

Provides for qualifications of levee board members (Item #1)

- Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works.

HB96 Carter, K. FLOODING

Provides criminal penalties for failure to perform lawful duties related to planning, design, construction, and maintenance of hurricane protection levees or flood control (Item #1)

- Read by title.

HB97 Carter, K. INSURANCE/HOMEOWNERS

Provides for disclosures of the terms of homeowners' policies by insurers (Item #36)

- Read by title, substitute title adopted, lies over in the same order of business, substitute for HB No. 42.

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| HB98 | Dorsey | HOUSING | Creates Louisiana Housing Recovery Centers (Item #2) - Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs. |
| HCR5 | Hebert | LOCAL GOVERNMENT | Memorializes congress to require FEMA to honor preferences of local governing authorities in determining the location of temporary housing sites - Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House. |
| HCR8 | Crowe | COLLEGES/TECHNICAL | Requests the governor, comm. of adm., Bd. of Regents, and LCTCS Bd. of Supervisors to take all actions necessary to facilitate and expedite the reopening of La. Technical College, Slidell Campus in the immediate future - Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House. |
| HCR13 | LaFonta | MORTGAGES | Urges and requests the banking industry to study the issue of mortgage holders retaining amounts of insurance settlement payments in excess of the unpaid portion of the secured indebtedness - Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House. |
| HCR16 | Johns | COMMENDATIONS | Commends former House Speaker E.L. "Bubba" Henry upon the celebration of his seventieth birthday - Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate. |
| HCR17 | Durand | TAX CREDITS | Memorializes congress to allow a \$500 tax deduction for people who offered rent-free housing to evacuees for at least two months as a result of Hurricane Rita - Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate. |
| HCR18 | Quezaire | COMMENDATIONS | Commends the organizers of and participants in Groundhog Job Shadow Day 2006 and welcomes those visiting the Louisiana State Capitol on this momentous occasion - Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate. |
| HCR19 | Crowe | POLICE/STATE | Urges and requests additional state troopers in St. Tammany Parish - Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate. |
| HCR20 | Hebert | PARISHES | Requests the president, governor, and congress to ensure enactment of legislation to require FEMA to provide the same level of assistance to the residents of certain parishes affected by Hurricane Rita as Louisiana residents affected by Hurricane Katrina - Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate. |
| HCR21 | Richmond | COMMENDATIONS | Commends Anheuser-Busch Companies for hurricane relief aid in 2005 - Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate. |
| SB2 | Theunissen | SCHOOLS | Delays from 2006 to 2007 the election of school board members in certain parishes and reduces from four years to three years the terms of those elected in 2007. (gov sig) - Received in the House from the Senate, read by title, lies over under the rules |
