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| HB1 | Burrell | PROPERTY/ABANDONED | Changes period of time from one hundred twenty days to sixty days for owners to contest the acquisition of abandoned property which was adjudicated to political subdivisions more than five years previously (Item #2) - Received from the Senate without amendments. |
| HB2 | Pinac | INSURANCE/PROPERTY | Authorizes the Louisiana Citizens Property Insurance Corporation to seek and accept federal Community Development Block Grant monies to pay bonds and obligations caused by hurricanes in 2005 (Item #35) - Received from the Senate with amendments. |
| HB3 | Alario | REVENUE SHARING | Provides relative to the FY 2005-2006 distribution of revenue sharing allocations in Orleans, Jefferson, Plaquemines, and St. Bernard parishes (Item #40) - Received from the Senate without amendments. |
| HB4 | LaFonta | INSURANCE/HOMEOWNERS | Requires that settlement payments on claims arising under homeowners' insurance policies be placed in interest-earning escrow accounts (Item #17) - Received from the Senate with amendments. |
| HB6 | St. Germain | ETHICS | Allows a public employee who was affected by a disaster or emergency to accept contributions or donations from certain not-for-profit organizations or funds within certain not-for-profit organizations (Item #25) - Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House. |
| HB12 | Jefferson | ELECTIONS | Allows registered voters temporarily displaced by a gubernatorially declared state of emergency who have registered by mail to vote absentee by mail without first voting in person at the polls or appearing or voting at the registrar's office (Item #19) - Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House. |
| HB17 | LaBruzzo | INSURANCE CLAIMS | Prohibits the automatic exclusion of certain coverages under a homeowner's policy for damages due to a declared disaster (Item # 5) - Received from the Senate with amendments. |
| HB18 | Hammett | TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION | Changes the effectiveness provision in Act No. 30 of the 2005 First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature (Item #22) - Received from the Senate without amendments. |
| HB21 | Hammett | TAX/INCOME TAX | Authorizes certain casualty loss deductions for 2004 tax year (Item #26) - Received from the Senate with amendments. |
| HB27 | Lancaster | TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION | Changes the election date from April 29, 2006, to September 30, 2006, for the submission of the proposed constitutional amendment contained in Act No. 70 of the 2005 First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature (Item #22) - Received from the Senate with amendments. |

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| HB28 | Lancaster | ELECTIONS/DATES | Repeals provisions for a special statewide election on April 29, 2006 (Item #18) - Received from the Senate without amendments. |
| HB29 | Lancaster | FUNDS/FUNDING | Changes the election date from April 29, 2006, to September 30, 2006, for the submission of the proposed constitutional amendment contained in Act No. 69 of the 2005 First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature (Item #21) - Received from the Senate without amendments. |
| HB40 | Richmond | PROPERTY | Provides relative to acquisitive prescription of blighted property (Item #2) - Received from the Senate without amendments. |
| HB46 | Arnold | ASSESSORS/PROPERTY ASSMT | Limits certain assessment procedures for property damaged by disaster or emergency declared by the storm (Item #16) - Received from the Senate with amendments. |
| HB47 | Triche | LEVEES/BDS & DISTRICTS | Provides for the consolidation of certain levee districts operating in Lafourche Parish (Item #1) - Received from the Senate with amendments. |
| HB49 | Ansardi | PUBLIC CONTRACTS | Authorizes Jefferson Parish to let design-build contracts for hurricane protection and flood control projects (Item #27) - Received from the Senate with amendments. |
| HB60 | Alario | TAX/SALES & USE | Provides that barges are subject to the exemption for ships and ships' supplies (Item #28) - Read by title, roll called, yeas 98, nays 0, Senate amendments concurred in. |
| HB61 | Thompson | GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION | Provides for the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness as an agency in the governor's office reporting directly to the governor (Item #6) - Received from the Senate with amendments. |
| HB70 | Jefferson | EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS | Requires the office of emergency preparedness to develop a comprehensive and coordinated evacuation plan for all coastal and hurricane-prone parishes (Item #6) - Received from the Senate with amendments. |
| HB71 | Alario | CAPITAL OUTLAY | Provides for supplemental capital outlay appropriation for the 2005-2006 Fiscal Year to the Department of Military Affairs (Item #24) - Received from the Senate without amendments. |
| HB78 | Montgomery | PUBLIC CONTRACTS | Authorizes the adjutant general and the Military Department to utilize the design-build method for certain construction projects (Item #23) - Received from the Senate without amendments. |
| HB88 | Gray | EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS | |

- HB90 Hammett BONDS
Provides relative to the limitation on net state tax supported debt for bonds issued to provide relief from Hurricanes Katrina and Rita (Item #34)

- HB93 Hammett BONDS
Authorizes state to issue bonds to provide relief from Hurricanes Katrina and Rita and implement certain bond provisions of the Gulf Opportunity Zone Act of 2005 (Item #33)

- HB97 Carter, K. INSURANCE/HOMEOWNERS
Provides for disclosures of the terms of homeowners' policies by insurers (Item #36)

Urges and requests the Department of Health and Hospitals to loosen restrictions regarding the Sanitary Code in hurricane-afflicted areas

SB8 Boasso FLOODS/FLOODING

Reorganizes the governance and structure of certain levee districts by creating and providing for a regional flood protection authority in southeast Louisiana. (gov sig)

- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 99, nays 3. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.

SB9 Boasso FLOODS/FLOODING

Constitutional amendment to provide for the establishment of regional flood protection authorities. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 100, nays 0. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, ordered to the Senate.

SB14 Cain PROPERTY INSURANCE

Prohibits certain activities of the Louisiana Citizens Property Insurance Corporation. (gov sig)

SB48 Shepherd RETIREMENT SYSTEMS

Allows the suspension and resumption of DROP participation for public school system employees terminated due to a reduction-in-force necessitated by hurricane Katrina or Rita. (gov sig)

SB49 Duplessis HOUSING

Creates the Louisiana Housing and Land Trust Corporation. (gov sig)

SCR20 Mount PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT

Requests state police to develop a contra-flow plan for evacuating citizens of Southwest Louisiana to include I-10 and U.S. Highways 165 and 171.
