- SB5 Murray TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL  
Grants a refundable credit against individual income tax for the Citizens Property Insurance surcharge if paid for the primary residence of the individual. (gov sig)  
- Rules suspended, recalled from committee.  
- Read by title, recommitted to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB10 Cain TAX EXEMPTIONS  
Grants a non-refundable individual income tax credit against certain federal itemized deductions, beginning in 2006. (gov sig)  
- Rules suspended, recalled from committee.  
- Read by title, recommitted to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB11 Cain TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL  
Grants a non-refundable individual income tax credit for 3% of the home mortgage interest and points and gifts to charity claimed as federal itemized deductions, beginning in 2006. (gov sig)  
- Rules suspended, recalled from committee.  
- Read by title, recommitted to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB12 Adley TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL  
Grants a refundable individual income tax credit for all of the home mortgage interest and points and gifts to charity claimed as federal itemized deductions, beginning in 2006. (gov sig)  
- Rules suspended, recalled from committee.  
- Read by title, recommitted to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB15 Cheek TAX/SALES  
Excludes from state sales tax the sale, use, lease or rental of certain machinery and equipment of motor vehicle manufacturers with an NAICS Code beginning with 3361. (gov sig)  
- Rules suspended, recalled from committee.  
- Read by title, recommitted to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB16 Mount TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL  
Grants a non-refundable individual income tax credit of 2% for medical and dental expenses, home mortgage interest and points, gifts to charity, and casualty and theft losses claimed as federal itemized deductions. (gov sig)  
- Rules suspended, recalled from committee.  
- Read by title, recommitted to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB17 Mount TAX/SALES  
Excludes from state sales tax the sale, use, lease or rental of certain machinery and equipment of motor vehicle manufacturers with an NAICS Code beginning with 3361. (gov sig)  
- Rules suspended, recalled from committee.  
- Read by title, recommitted to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB18 Jackson, L. TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL  
Grants a refundable "child tax credit" against individual income tax of \$50 per child. (gov sig)  
- Rules suspended, recalled from committee.  
- Read by title, recommitted to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB19 Mount TAX/TAXATION  
Extends to June 30, 2007, the time for filing various matters related to succession and inheritance tax for deaths occurring after October 31, 2004, and before January 1, 2006, and authorizes the secretary

- Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on Finance.
- HCR7 Schneider INSURANCE/PROPERTY  
Memorializes congress to enact legislation creating a federal catastrophe fund  
- Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call
- HCR9 Tucker HOUSING  
Urge and request the Division of Administration, office of community development, and the Louisiana Recovery Authority to revise the Road Home Program to permit banks to participate as contractors for homeowner assistance activities  
- Received in the Senate; rules suspended; read first time by title, lies over under the rules.
- HCR10 Tucker CONDOLENCES  
Expresses condolences upon the death of former state representative Edward "Bud Rip" Ripoll, Jr., of New Orleans  
- Received in the Senate. Rules suspended, read by title and concurred in by the vote of 29 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.
- HCR11 Bruneau INSURANCE/POLICIES  
Urges and requests the commissioner of insurance to extend the period of time during which certain homeowner insurance policies cannot be cancelled  
- Received in the Senate; rules suspended; read first time by title, lies over under the rules.
- HCR12 Richmond COMMENDATIONS  
Commends Dr. Norman C. Francis, president of Xavier University, for his accomplishments, for his contributions to the university and as LRA chairman, and upon being chosen to receive the Presidential Medal of Freedom
