Repeals the jurisdiction of DEQ to regulate noise pollution.
- Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB128 Jones CRIMINAL JUSTICE
Removes prohibition on medical parole consideration for inmates with contagious diseases.
- Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB133 Gautreaux, N. CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Requires participants in a pilot electronic monitoring program to be employed and pay fees related to the costs and limits eligibility to sex offenders and domestic abuse offenders.

- SB216 Jackson, L. PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT
Provides for the issuance of special officer commissions in the event of a declared emergency or disaster. (gov sig)

- SB226 Gautreaux, N. LAW ENFORCEMENT
Repeals mandatory age requirement for constables to retire. (gov sig)
- Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.

Authorizes the secretary of DEQ to implement an expedited permit processing program.

Authorizes the commissioner of the office of financial institutions to obtain certain state and federal criminal history records. (CA7s2.1(A)) (gov sig)

Allows the office of financial institutions to collect a fee when payment is returned unpaid or is refused or declined. (2/3-CA7s2.1(A)) (gov sig)

Requires collection agencies to be licensed and bonded in order to do business in the state of Louisiana. (2/3-CA7s2.1(A))
