- Read by title, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar. |
| HB28 | Tucker | ETHICS | Relative to violations of laws under Board of Ethics' jurisdiction, specifically makes applicable certain provisions and penalties relative to the crime of filing of false public documents and provides relative to referral of criminal violations to the district attorney and his access to related records

| HB29 | Tucker | ETHICS/BOARD | Provides relative to the qualifications for service on the Board of Ethics (Item #4(4))

| HB33 | Peterson | ETHICS | Provides relative to persons designated to provide information relative to ethics and conflicts of interest to public servants in certain state agencies (Item #4)
- Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar. |
| HB41 | Tucker | ETHICS/BOARD | Provides relative to enforcement of laws within the jurisdiction of the Board of Ethics (Items #4(5) and (7))
- Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar. |
| HB43 | Peterson | CAMPAIGN FINANCE | Provides that a campaign finance fine, fee, or penalty may only be paid by the person against whom the fine, fee, or penalty was assessed (Item #7 and 9)

| HB48 | Greene | RETIREMENT BENEFITS | (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for forfeiture of retirement benefits by public officials and employees who are convicted of felony acts associated with their positions (Item #4 (16))
- Read by title, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar. |
| HB52 | Peterson | ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS | Requires the Board of Ethics and the ethics administrator to file annual financial disclosure statements (Item # 1 and 2)
- Reported with amendments (16-0) (Regular). |
| HB58 | Morrell | ELECTIONS | Requires certain disclosures for the conduct of certain telephone communications and polling (Item #7(1))
- Reported with amendments (16-0) (Regular). |
| HB62 | Hardy | ETHICS/CODE | Requires the Board of Ethics to impose certain penalties on a person who has violated law within the jurisdiction of the board to his economic advantage (Item #4)
- Reported favorably (7-5) (Regular). |

HB65	Greene	ETHICS	Prohibits an individual with outstanding ethics fines from qualifying as a candidate for elected office (Item #7(1)) - Reported with amendments (15-0) (Regular).
HB72	Barrow	CAMPAIGN FINANCE	Allows the use of campaign funds for certain gifts for constituents (Item #7) - Reported with amendments (10-0) (Regular).
HB73	White	CAMPAIGN FINANCE	Provides relative to filing reports by political committees (Item #7) - Reported with amendments (10-0) (Regular).
HB74	Connick	ETHICS/CODE	Provides for a process for declaratory opinions of the Board of Ethics (Item #4) - Reported with amendments (16-0) (Regular).
HB78	Leger	CAMPAIGN FINANCE	Requires certain candidates for major and district offices to file disclosure reports electronically (Item #7) - Reported with amendments (17-0) (Regular).
HB80	Morrell	MUNICIPAL/HOME RULE	Provides relative to certain investigative and subpoena powers of a local ethics entity, local ethics review board, or office of inspector general in certain home rule municipalities - Reported with amendments (10-0) (Regular).
HB89	Richard	CAMPAIGN FINANCE	Prohibits the use of campaign funds to pay fines, fees, and penalties assessed pursuant to the Campaign Finance Disclosure Act (Item #7) - Reported favorably (17-0) (Regular).
HB90	Dixon	ETHICS/BOARD	Provides relative to the enforcement procedures of the Board of Ethics (Item #4) - Reported favorably (16-0) (Regular).
HB91	Morrell	ETHICS/BOARD	Provides for an executive counsel to the board (Item #4) - Reported with amendments (16-0) (Regular).
HB92	Morrell	ETHICS/BOARD	Provides relative to hearings by the Board of Ethics (Item #4) - Read by title. - Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on House and Governmental Affairs.
HB93	Morrell	ETHICS/BOARD	Provides relative to discovery of information obtained pursuant to private investigations conducted by the Board of Ethics (Item #4(1))

HB94 Jones, Sam ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS
Excludes from financial disclosure requirements information related to any income, property, business enterprise, or other interests of the spouse of certain elected and appointed officials included in a prenuptial agreement (Item #1)

HB95 Hines CAMPAIGN FINANCE
Requires political advertisements paid for by a person other than a candidate or his principal or subsidiary committee to include a statement identifying the person who paid for the advertisement and stating whether it was authorized by the candidate or his committee (Item #7(2))

HR12 Dixon COMMENDATIONS
Commends Dr. Khem Aggarwal for his contributions to higher education

HR13 Connick LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR
Requests the legislative auditor to conduct a performance audit on the Crescent City Connection Division within the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development

HR14 Richmond HOUSE/RULES
Requires that equal time be allowed for questions when the governor or another person addresses the House while in session

SB5 Chaisson ELECTED OFFICIALS
Eliminates provision authorizing certain elected officials to vote upon matters which would otherwise present a conflict of interest. (gov sig)

- Received in the House from the Senate, read by title, lies over under the rules
