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SB12	Michot	ETHICS	Requires statewide elected officials, members of the Board of Ethics, and legislators to disclose certain financial information on an annual basis and requires candidates for statewide elective office and the legislature to disclose such information at the time of qualifying. (gov sig) - Read by title and referred to the committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
SB13	Murray	JUSTICE DEPARTMENT	Constitutional amendment to grant original jurisdiction to the attorney general to institute and prosecute cases of public corruption. (2/3-CA13s1(A)) - Read by title and referred to the committee on Judiciary B.
SB14	Marionneaux	ELECTION CODE	Requires the name of third-party entities on the face of paid political advertisements. (1/1/10) - Read by title and referred to the committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
SB15	Scalise	RETIREMENT BENEFITS	Requires forfeiture of public retirement or pension benefits upon conviction of certain felonies. - Read by title and referred to the committee on Retirement.
SB16	Scalise	RETIREMENT BENEFITS	Requires forfeiture of public retirement or pension benefits of elected officials convicted of certain felonies. - Read by title and referred to the committee on Retirement.
SB17	Scalise	RETIREMENT BENEFITS	Constitutional amendment to allow forfeiture of benefits from any public retirement or pension system, plan, or fund member upon conviction of a felony. (2/3-CA 13s1(A)) - Read by title and referred to the committee on Retirement.

SB21	McPherson	ETHICS	Requires all expenditures attributable to each "public servant" to be included in the report required to be filed by registered lobbyists and provides for exceptions for group occasions. - Read by title and referred to the committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
SB22	Nevers	ETHICS	Prohibits legislators and certain other elected officials from entering into contracts with the state and certain political subdivisions thereof unless competitively bid under the Public Bid Law. (gov sig) - Read by title and referred to the committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.

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Prohibits candidates for elected office from using campaign contributions to pay family members. (gov sig)

SB35 Chaisson ETHICS

Prohibits the use of counter letters and similar methods to avoid compliance with the Code of Governmental Ethics. (gov sig)

Establishes procedures for the attorney general to mediate public records disputes. (8/15/08)

Requires the commissioner of administration to establish and maintain a website to post reports of state spending by agency. (8/15/08)

Provides for the Louisiana Electronic Catalog. (8/15/08)

Provides relative to civil and criminal penalties for violations of laws relative to meetings of public bodies and public records, including discipline and termination or removal of public employees and certain public officials (gov sig).

Prohibits threat of reprisal against a public employee for reporting acts of alleged impropriety. (gov sig)

Creates a special committee to study and develop recommendations for facilitating the ability of co-owners of inherited immovable property to make their titles merchantable.
- Introduced in the Senate, rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
- SCR3 Alario FEDERAL PROGRAMS
Memorializes Congress to reduce or eliminate the Social Security reductions known as the Windfall Elimination Provision and the Government Pension Offset.
- Introduced in the Senate, rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on Retirement.
- SCR4 Crowe COMMENDATIONS
Commends the South Plaquemines Hurricanes on winning the state football championship.
- Introduced in the Senate. Read by title, rules suspended, adopted by the vote of 33 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.
