Provides restrictions and disclosure requirements for contracts involving certain public servants and certain affiliated persons and entities. (gov sig)
- Rules suspended. Amendments proposed by the House read and rejected, 34 yeas and 0 nays. Conference committee appointments pending. Motion to reconsider tabled.
 - Senate conference committee appointed: Chaisson, Kostelka, and Broome.

- SB3 Chaisson ETHICS
Repeals the gift exception for elected officials for cultural and sporting events. (gov sig)

Chaisson ADMINISTRATION DIVISION

Requires the commissioner of administration to establish and maintain a website to post reports of state spending by agency. (gov sig)

SB47

Adley CAMPAIGN FINANCE

Provides for felony violations of election campaign finance law. (3/30/08)

SB53

Murray CRIME/PUNISHMENT

Increases penalties for the crime of corrupt influencing. (gov sig)

SB58

Martiny CRIME/PUNISHMENT

Creates the crime of abuse of office. (gov sig)

HB1 Tucker ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS
Requires certain public servants and candidates for certain offices to disclose certain financial information (Item #1)

HB6 Tucker ETHICS
Provides relative to ethics education and training (Item #4 and 4(2))

- Signed by the President of the Senate.

HB22 Champagne ETHICS/NEPOTISM
Provides relative to the prohibition on employment by a governmental entity of family members of certain officials of the governmental entity (Item #4)

- Signed by the President of the Senate.

HB23 Leger ETHICS/CODE
Allows participation in the Wills for Heroes program by certain public servants (Item #4)

- Signed by the President of the Senate.

HB29 Tucker ETHICS/BOARD
Provides relative to the qualifications for service on the Board of Ethics (Item #4(4))

- Signed by the President of the Senate.

HB33 Peterson ETHICS
Provides relative to persons designated to provide information relative to ethics and conflicts of interest to public servants in certain state agencies (Item #4)

- Signed by the President of the Senate.

HB41 Tucker ETHICS/BOARD
Provides relative to enforcement of laws within the jurisdiction of the Board of Ethics (Items #4(5) and (7))

Requires certain candidates for major and district offices to file disclosure reports electronically (Item #7)
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HB80 Morrell MUNICIPAL/HOME RULE
Provides relative to certain investigative and subpoena powers of a local ethics entity, local ethics review board, or office of inspector general in certain home rule municipalities
- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title and finally passed as amended, 37 yeas and 0 nays; title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB90 Dixon ETHICS/BOARD
Provides relative to the enforcement procedures of the Board of Ethics (Item #4)
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HCR7 Hoffmann SOCIAL SECURITY SYS
Memorializes congress to review and consider eliminating the Government Pension Offset (GPO) and the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP) social security benefit reductions
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HCR16 Wooton FISHING
Expresses the legislature's opposition to the development of deepwater fish farms off the coast of Louisiana
