HB9	Richmond	TAX CREDITS	Increases the total aggregate amount of credits that may be taken under the new markets tax credit (Item #5) - Reported with amendments (18-0) (Regular).
HB18	Greene	TAX/INCOME TAX	Provides that certain federal income tax rebates or credits shall not reduce the federal income tax deduction (Item #12) - Reported favorably (17-0) (Regular).
