HB1	Greene	TAX/SALES-USE, STATE	Provides relative to the effectiveness of the state sales and use tax exemption for sales of electricity, natural gas, water, and steam (Item #2) - Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 101, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB2	Greene	TAX/SALES & USE	Accelerates phase-in of the sales tax exclusion for purchases of manufacturing machinery and equipment (Item #1) - Read by title, returned to the calendar.
HB3	Greene	TAX/CORP FRANCHISE	Accelerates the elimination of borrowed capital from the tax base of the corporation franchise tax (Item #4) - Read by title, returned to the calendar.
HB4	Tucker	FUNDS/FUNDING	Provides for the dedication of certain revenues to transportation (Item #6) - Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 102, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB5	Tucker	TREASURY DEPARTMENT	Authorizes investment of monies in state treasury in tax exempt bonds issued by the Louisiana Stadium and Exposition District (Item #13) - Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 104, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB6	Dove	FUNDS/FUNDING	Provides for the deposit of monies into the Coastal Restoration and Protection Fund (Item #11) - Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 103, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB7	Greene	TAX/INCOME TAX	Authorizes individual income tax deductions for elementary and secondary school tuition, certain educational expenses for home-schooling children, and elementary and secondary school expenses (Item #7(2)) - Read by title, returned to the calendar.
HB9	Richmond	TAX CREDITS	Increases the total aggregate amount of credits that may be taken under the new markets tax credit (Item #5) - Read by title, returned to the calendar. - Called from the calendar. - Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 104, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB18	Greene	TAX/INCOME TAX	Provides that certain federal income tax rebates or credits shall not reduce the federal income tax deduction (Item #12) - Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 101, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB30	Lambert	FUNDS/FUNDING

Provides for the dedication of state revenues from truck and trailer licensing and registration (Item #6)
- Read by title, returned to the calendar.

HB36 St. Germain APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML
Provides supplemental appropriation for Fiscal Year 2007-2008 for payments against the initial Unfunded Accrued Liability of the public retirement systems (Item #8)
- Read by title, returned to the calendar.

HB40 Mills TAX/INCOME TAX
Authorizes individual income tax deductions for elementary and secondary school tuition under certain circumstances and for certain educational expenses at certain elementary and secondary schools (Item #7(1))
- Read by title, returned to the calendar.

HB45 Arnold DISTRICTS/ECONOMIC DEVEL
Provides relative to the Algiers Development District (Item #10)
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 103, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.

HB46 Fannin APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML
Provides for supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2007-2008 (Item #8)
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 103, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.

HCR1 Fannin BUDGETARY PROCEDURES
Provides for the expenditure limit for Fiscal Year 2007-2008 (Item #9)
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 101, nays 2. The resolution, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.

HCR7 Jones, Rosalind COMMENDATIONS

HR6 Danahay SCHOOLS
Requests the Beauregard Parish School Board to reconsider its decision to close Hyatt High School in Fields, La.

HR7 Foil COMMENDATIONS

HR8 Geymann COMMENDATIONS
Commends CHRISTUS St. Patrick Hospital in Lake Charles upon its centennial anniversary
- Read by title, rules suspended, adopted.

HR9 Smith, Jane COMMENDATIONS
Commends Dr. Jack Bagent of Bossier Parish upon his induction into the Louisiana 4-H Hall of Fame

SB3 Scalise TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Provides that the deduction from Louisiana income for federal income taxes will not decrease because of the federal income tax reductions (i.e. the rebates) in the federal Economic Stimulus Act of 2008. (gov sig)
- Received in the House from the Senate, read by title, lies over under the rules

SB5 Marionneaux TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Grants an individual income tax deduction for tuition and fees paid on and after 1/1/09 to enroll a child in a parochial, private, college or university-affiliated elementary and secondary school, and for text books and curricula for home-schooled students, both limited to \$5,000 per child.
- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

SB7 Chaisson TAX/SALES
Defines as a "manufacturer" for the manufacturing machinery and equipment sales tax exclusion persons within NAISC code information Sector 51 or the manufacturing Sectors 511-511110 if they are required to register with the Department of Labor and are assigned such sector numbers. (gov sig)
- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

SB9 Marionneaux TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Provides that the deduction from Louisiana income for federal income taxes will not decrease because of federal income tax rebates and credits received in 2008 from the federal Economic Stimulus Act of 2008. (8/15/08)
- Received in the House from the Senate, read by title, lies over under the rules

SB10 Marionneaux TAX/FRANCHISE/CORPORATE
Accelerates the phase-out of corporate franchise tax on "borrowed capital" by one year, by excluding all "borrowed capital" from "taxable capital" for tax years beginning in 2011 (instead of 2012) and thereafter. (See Act)
- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

SB11 Michot FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for dedication of certain revenues to transportation. (gov sig)
- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

SB12 Marionneaux TAX/SALES
Accelerates the phase-out of state sales taxes on manufacturing machinery and equipment by one year, making the purchase or lease of such machinery and equipment beginning 7/1/09 and thereafter tax free. (7/1/08)
- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
