

Legislative Day History
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- SB18 Alario TREASURY DEPARTMENT
Re-creates the Department of the Treasury and its agencies. (6/30/09)
- Reported favorably.
- SB41 Dupre FUNDS/FUNDING
Changes the name of the Mineral Resources Operation Fund to the Mineral and Energy Operation Fund and requires the fund to be used by the Department of Natural Resources for the regulation of minerals, ground water and related energy activities. (7/1/09)
- Reported with amendments.
- SB84 Adley PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Increases the maximum amount of materials and supplies that can be purchased without public bid to \$40,000. (8/15/09)
- Rules suspended. Read by title and recommitted to the Committee on Local and Municipal Affairs.
- SB91 Gautreaux, N. TAX/ENERGY
Provides a transferable tax credit for income and corporation franchise taxes of 25% of the costs and expenses attributable to the construction or for the installation of certain qualified energy resources limited to \$3.75 million per qualified energy resource. (gov sig)
- Rules suspended. Read by title and recommitted to the Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs.
- SB138 Walsworth INSURERS
Provides for demutualization of mutual non-life insurance holding companies. (8/15/09)
- Reported with amendments.
- SB139 Riser TAX/SALES
Ends the "suspension" of the sales tax exemption granted for meals furnished to the staff, faculty, and students of educational institutions, makes it retroactive to January 1, 1998, and specifically includes meals paid for in advance pursuant to certain meal plans at such institutions. (gov sig)

- SB177 Martiny INSURANCE DEPARTMENT
Provides for hearing held for and by the Department of Insurance. (8/15/09)

- SB206 Adley TAX EXEMPTIONS
Exempts from state and local sales tax the sale of construction materials to Fuller Center for Housing covenant partners intended for use in constructing new residential dwellings in this state. (7/1/09)

- SB225 Morrish COASTAL PROTECT/RES AUTH
Provides relative to Louisiana Coastal Protection, Conservation, Restoration and Management. (8/15/09)

- SB306 Adley FUNDS/FUNDING
Dedicates a portion of certain mineral revenues to be used to develop infrastructure needs for alternative water sources and other local needs. (7/1/09)

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- Provides for changes to the Louisiana Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Association Law. (8/15/09)

- SB323 Adley LEVEES
Creates and provides for the North Bossier Levee and Drainage District. (08/15/09)
- Rules suspended. Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works.
- SCR14 Dupre COASTAL RESOURCES
Approves the annual Coastal Protection Plan for Fiscal Year 2009 - 2010.
- Reported favorably.
- SCR15 Michot CONGRESS
