- SB24 Amedee REAL ESTATE
Adds two at-large members to the Louisiana Real Estate Commission.
- Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB29 Riser TELECOMMUNICATIONS
Enacts the Louisiana Anti-Caller ID Spoofing Act. (8/15/09)
- Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB38 Michot TECHNOLOGY
Increases the membership of the Louisiana Immersive Technologies Enterprises Board of Commissioners from five to seven. (8/15/09)
- Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB51 Heitmeier HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT
Authorizes the Department of Health and Hospitals to accept intergovernmental transfers from local governing bodies for the purpose of enhancing the provision of health care services for uninsured and Medicaid patients. (8/15/09)
- Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB91 Gautreaux, N. TAX/ENERGY
Provides a transferable tax credit for income and corporation franchise taxes of 25% of the costs and expenses attributable to the construction or for the installation of certain qualified energy resources limited to \$3.75 million per qualified energy resource. (gov sig)
- Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB93 Thompson COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Requires food processors to maintain a written food safety and recall plan and to report positive test results for dangerous contaminants to the Department of Health and Hospitals. (gov sig)
- Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB105 Duplessis COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Provides relative to mortgage fraud. (8/15/09)
- Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB110 Marionneaux CREDIT
Provides relative to the Credit Repair Services Organizations Act.
- Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB183 Appel COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES
Constitutional amendment to exempt postsecondary education tuition and fee amounts at public institutions from the requirements for imposing and increasing fees. (2/3-CA13s1(A))
- Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB191 Alario HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT
Provides authority for the Department of Health and Hospitals to conduct certain mortality reviews. (gov sig)
- Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB211 Claitor ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
Establishes and provides for the Louisiana Innovation Council. (8/15/09)

- HB183 Hoffmann TEACHERS/CERTIFICATION
Requires BESE to establish an appeals process for applicants who have been denied teacher certification

- HB227 Greene PUBLIC PRINTING
Removes certain exemptions relative to public printing requirements for certain state agencies
- Received in the Senate. Rules suspended. Read first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
- HB235 Champagne BOATS/SHIPS/VESSELS
Applies aggravated flight from an officer statutes to watercraft
- Received in the Senate. Rules suspended. Read first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary B.
- HB253 Guillory, Elbert CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS
Amends provisions of law regarding work release programs and eligibility

Amends the criminal penalty for the crime of racketeering
