Provides with respect to the sunset provisions of the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness. (6/30/10)  
- Read by title. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading and final passage.
- SB153 Erdey HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE  
Relative to the high risk health insurance pool. (gov sig)  
- Read by title. Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading and final passage.
- SB168 Walsworth CEMETERIES  
Provides for extension of time for the construction of cemetery facilities due to force majeure. (8/15/10)

- SB185 Gautreaux, N. ELECTION CODE

- SB192 Mount CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION  
Provides for an exemption to licensure as a day care center for certain religious organizations. (gov sig)

- SB194 Duplessis EMPLOYMENT  
Provides relative to employment contracts. (8/15/10)

- SB256 Chaisson COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS  
Enacts the Louisiana Exchange Sale of Receivables Act. (gov sig)

Reorganizes and renames the Department of Social Services. (gov sig)
