HB974	Carter	TEACHERS	Provides relative to teacher tenure, pay-for-performance, and evaluations - Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 64, nays 40. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HCR50	Henry	AMUSEMENTS/SPORTS	Requests that the National Football League reconsider the penalties imposed upon the New Orleans Saints - Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HCR51	Jackson, K	MEDICAID	Suspends administrative rules providing for Medicaid Coordinated Care Networks - Read by title. Lies over under the rules.
HR11	Arnold	COMMENDATIONS	Commends Taiwan's participation as an observer in the International Civil Aviation Organization and the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change - Enrolled, signed by the Speaker of the House and taken by the Clerk of the House to the Secretary of State in accordance with the Rules of the House.
HR13	Bishop, Stuart	COMMENDATIONS	Commends the St. Thomas More High School girls basketball team of Lafayette upon winning the state championship - Enrolled, signed by the Speaker of the House and taken by the Clerk of the House to the Secretary of State in accordance with the Rules of the House.
SB193	Guillory, E	MOTOR VEHICLES	Provides for prestige license plates for the Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. (8/1/12) - Received in the House from the Senate, read by title, lies over under the rules
SB581	Appel	EARLY CHILDHOOD ED	Provides for the La. Early Childhood Education Act. (gov sig) - Received in the House from the Senate, read by title, lies over under the rules
SB610	Riser	TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL	Provides relative to the uniformity of distribution dates for donations to donees. (6/30/12) - Received in the House from the Senate, read by title, lies over under the rules
