- SB 70 MURRAY SUCCESSIONS
Provides relative to small succession procedures and effects. (gov sig)
- SB 75 KOSTELKA CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Creates the crimes of failure to report a missing child and failure to report death of a child. (gov sig)
- SB 86 BUFFINGTON SANITARY CODE
Clarifies duties of healthcare providers as it relates to communicable diseases. (gov sig)
- SB 88 BUFFINGTON ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE
Requires state agencies to provide notice upon submission of certain reports to the legislature. (1/1/13)
- SB 105 MORRELL PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT
Provides a monetary penalty for the introduction of contraband into a correctional facility by a visitor. (8/1/12)
- SB 116 MILLS HEALTH SERVICES
Provides for the naming of certain human services districts. (gov sig)
- SB 118 SMITH, GARY INSURANCE COMMISSIONER
Grants authority to the La. Insurance Commissioner to promulgate regulations for independent review of benefit determinations. (8/1/12)
- SB 120 MILLS BANKS/BANKING
Provides relative to qualified appraisals of immovable property acquired by a bank from a failed or failing bank. (8/1/12)
- SB 122 WHITE SEX OFFENSES
Provides relative to the registration of sex offenders. (gov sig)
- SB 130 CROWE CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Prohibits the sale of Kratom to or the purchase or possession of Kratom by any person under 18 years of age. (gov sig)
- SB 145 MILLS HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT
Deletes references to supports and services centers and employment service programs within the Department of Health and Hospitals that no longer exist. (gov sig)
- SB 146 LONG INSURANCE DEPARTMENT
Prohibits public adjusters from acting as appraisers on claims they are adjusting. (8/1/12)
- SB 148 THOMPSON, F AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES
Provides relative to changes in the Agricultural Commodity Dealer and Warehouse Law and repeals certain provisions related to cooperative marketing agreements. (gov sig)
- SB 149 THOMPSON, F FARMING
Provides relative to the registration of agricultural liming materials and provides for technical changes. (gov sig)
- SB 150 THOMPSON, F AGRICULTURE/FOREST DEPT
Provides relative to the membership of certain commissions within the Department of Agriculture and Forestry. (gov sig)
- SB 151 THOMPSON, F PESTICIDES/HERBICIDES
Provides relative to the Pesticide Law and extends pesticide records retention requirements. (gov sig)
- SB 164 MARTINY BANKS/BANKING
Provides relative to loans by state banks and limitations on loans. (gov sig)
- SB 169 ALLAIN AGRICULTURE/FOREST DEPT
Provides relative to the membership of the Louisiana Strawberry Marketing Board. (gov sig)
- SB 192 ADLEY FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS
Provides for licensure of individuals with military training and their spouses. (8/1/12)
- SB 208 MORRISH PROPERTY INSURANCE
Adds a representative of the La. Surplus Lines Association and the Deputy Commissioner for Consumer Advocacy to the membership of the La. Property and Casualty Commission. (8/1/12)

- SB 212 MILLS PHARMACISTS
Provides relative to a specific date for the term of appointment of board members. (gov sig)
- SB 218 JOHNS PHARMACISTS
Authorizes the Louisiana Board of Pharmacy to waive annual renewal requirements for pharmacist licenses and technician certifications for individuals serving in active duty in the military service. (8/1/12)
- SB 235 MILLS HOSPITALS
Authorizes local entities to identify certain funds in an effort to maximize revenues for health care purposes. (gov sig)
- SB 263 MARTINY CIVIL PROCEDURE
Provides relative to service of process and the secretary of state. (8/1/12)
- SB 280 MURRAY JUDGES
Extends the term of the judge of Division D of New Orleans Traffic Court, then abolishes Division D, followed by Division A. (gov sig)
- SB 281 JOHNS INSURANCE DEPARTMENT
Provides for confidentiality of records and reporting of complaints against persons and entities subject to jurisdiction of the Department of Insurance. (gov sig)
- SB 288 ALLAIN AGRICULTURE/FOREST COMR
Authorizes the commissioner of agriculture to employ an executive counsel and assistants. (gov sig)
- SB 315 AMEDEE SUNSET LAW
Re-creates the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism. (6/30/12)
- SB 318 MARTINY ENGINEERS
Provides relative to naval architects and marine engineers and the authority of the Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board. (gov sig)
- SB 354 AMEDEE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE
Provides for electronic reporting of rule changes to legislative oversight committees. (8/1/12)
- SB 359 MORRISH AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE
Provides for selection or rejection of uninsured motorist coverage pursuant to the Louisiana Uniform Electronic Transactions Act. (8/1/12)
- SB 391 RISER HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE
Exempts La. Medicaid programs from insurers who may be taxed by a municipal or parochial corporation. (7/1/12)
- SB 393 MURRAY CIVIL PROCEDURE
Provides relative to eviction proceedings and motions for new trial. (gov sig)
- SB 394 SMITH, GARY INSURERS
Changes the rehabilitation, liquidation, and conservation provisions. (8/1/12)
- SB 422 CLAITOR ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE
Provides relative to legislative review of emergency rules or fees. (gov sig)
- SB 551 MILLS INSURANCE DEPARTMENT
Repeals the legislator exemption from continuing education requirements for license renewal. (1/1/13)
- SB 595 CROWE PUBLIC RECORDS
Creates the "Business Identity Theft Prevention Act". (gov sig)
