Prohibits the sale of Kratom to or the purchase or possession of Kratom by any person under 18 years of age. (gov sig)
- SB 281 JOHNS INSURANCE DEPARTMENT
Provides for confidentiality of records and reporting of complaints against persons and entities subject to jurisdiction of the Department of Insurance. (gov sig)
- SB 463 WALSWORTH TAX/INCOME/CORPORATE
Establishes the Corporate Tax Apportionment Program for the granting of contracts for certain businesses to utilize the single sales factor to compute their taxable for income tax purposes and their taxable capital for franchise tax purposes. (7/1/12)
- SB 546 PEACOCK COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Permits non-resident vendors of recreational products to exhibit at recreational product shows, fairs and festivals. (gov sig)
