- SB 386 WARD WORKERS' COMPENSATION
Provides for payment of medical benefits within 30 days rather than 60 days contingent upon medical providers' adoption and utilization of electronic billing rules and regulations. (8/1/12)
- SB 387 WARD HUNTERS/HUNTING
Provides for the positive evidence of sex identification of deer and turkey. (8/1/12)
- SB 454 LAFLEUR LEASES
Provides for the leasing and ratification of certain leases of school lands and sixteenth section lands. (gov sig)
- SB 496 PERRY MUNICIPALITIES
Provides relative to the authority of the chief of police for the city of Kaplan and the position of assistant to the chief of police. (8/1/12)
- SB 499 RISER BONDS
Prohibits the State Bond Commission from approving bonds, notes, or other indebtedness of political subdivisions against whom there is an unpaid final, nonappealable judgment issued by a court of competent jurisdiction for amounts owed for services performed under contract. (8/1/12)
- SB 502 CLAITOR WATER QUALITY
Requires annual reports from certain special districts regarding its groundwater resources. (gov sig)
- SB 512 MORRELL SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Streamlines the procedure by which municipalities and parishes create neighborhood security districts. (8/1/12)
- SB 523 HEITMEIER LEVEES
Relative to the funding of the Algiers Levee District and the Orleans Levee District from tax proceeds. (gov sig)
- SB 525 ALLAIN MINERALS
Requires the commissioner of conservation to promulgate rules that require notice be provided to certain landowners affected by drilling operations. (8/1/12)
- SB 549 MILLS FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for appropriations from the St. Martin Parish Enterprise Fund to be made to the St. Martin Parish government for tourism and economic development. (gov sig)
- SB 558 ERDEY MOTOR VEHICLES
Reduces from \$8 to \$6 the additional motor vehicle inspection charge or fee charged for each inspection that includes performance of inspection and maintenance (I/M) program in non-attainment areas. (8/1/12)

Authorizes the commissioner of administration to transfer certain property in Lincoln Parish to Grambling State University and to Louisiana Tech University. (8/1/12)

- SB 617 DONAHUE SPECIAL DISTRICTS
