Establishes the Corporate Tax Apportionment Program for the granting of contracts for certain businesses to utilize the single sales factor to compute their taxable for income tax purposes and their taxable capital for franchise tax purposes. (7/1/12)
- SB 482 PERRY CRIMINAL PROCEDURE
Provides relative to the taking of depositions of a child victim of sexual abuse. (8/1/12)
