HB 207	CARMODY	PUBLIC BLDGS/GROUNDS-ST Authorizes each public postsecondary education management board to name a building at an institution under its supervision and management in honor of a living person
HB 298	CHANEY	LEGISLATIVE POWERS Provides relative to the membership of the La. Commission on Civic Education
HB 540	JONES, SAM	TEACHERS Repeals provisions of law relative to teacher certification by the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards
HB 618	LEOPOLD	SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES Provides relative to salary

supplements for public school educational diagnosticians

- HB 635** **WILLIAMS, P** **SCHOOLS/BOARDS** Requires local public school boards to adopt policies relative to accommodations for employees to express breast milk
- HB 612** **GREENE** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP** Permits use of TOPS awards at eligible La. institutions by otherwise qualified students who graduated from out-of-state colleges or universities
- HB 650** **CARTER** **GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION** Provides relative to the organization of the state Department of Education
