#### INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

<b>HB 304 TALBOT</b>	<b>TAX/TOBACCO TAX</b> Increases the state tax levied on cigarettes
<b>HB 417 RITCHIE</b>	<b>TAX/TOBACCO TAX</b> Increases the state tax on certain tobacco products and dedicates the monies
<b>HB 537 JACKSON, K</b>	<b>TAX/TOBACCO TAX</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Levies an additional tax on cigarettes and other tobacco products and authorizes the dedication of such monies
<b>HB 623 JACKSON, K</b>	<b>TAX/TOBACCO TAX</b> Increases the state tax on certain tobacco products

#### INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

<b>HB 75 BISHOP, WESLEY</b>	<b>TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT</b> Provides for a state sales and use tax exemption for sales of certain property to "St. Bernard Project, Inc."
<b>HB 377 LEGER</b>	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Establishes a registry for tax credits and provides relative to the period of time to report claims or a transfer to the registry
<b>HB 418 EDWARDS</b>	<b>TAX/SALES &amp; USE</b> Provides with respect to the state and local sales and use tax exemption for sales at certain events sponsored by nonprofit organizations
<b>HB 455 LEGER</b>	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Establishes the Louisiana New Markets Jobs tax credit
<b>HB 474 BISHOP, STUART</b>	<b>ENERGY/DRILLING</b> Provides relative to the exemption from severance tax for inactive wells
<b>HB 483 LANDRY, NANCY</b>	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Extends authority to grant tax credits for certain state-certified musical or theatrical facility infrastructure projects
<b>HB 629 BROADWATER</b>	<b>REVENUE DEPARTMENT</b> Establishes the office of debt recovery at the Dept. of Revenue for the collection of delinquent debts owed to certain governmental entities
<b>HB 630 LEGER</b>	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Provides for the transferability of the income tax credit for the rehabilitation of historic commercial structures
<b>HB 631 BISHOP, WESLEY</b>	<b>TAX</b> Removes the exclusion of the city of New Orleans and the parish of Orleans relative to the offset of individual income tax refunds
