This public meeting is being held pursuant to the requirements of Revised Statute 27:30.6 regarding the establishment of the annual fee for the administration of the Division Central Computer System, DCCS, for the fiscal year 2014/2015. Section I of the above states in part

"The Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police shall impose and collect an annual fee not in excess of 50 dollars on each electronic gaming device linked by telecommunication to the central computer system as provided by this section.

"The purpose of the fee shall be to defray the costs to the state of acquiring, implementing, and maintaining the central computer system as provided for in this section.

The annual fee will be established in an amount which will generate an amount of funds in each fiscal year, which is equal to the projected cost of administering the system for that fiscal year."

It is intended to establish the fee in compliance with Section I of the above act, which requires that the amount of the proposed fee is limited to generating funds to defray the costs of administering the central computer system for that fiscal year.

This hearing is only to receive comments regarding the proposed fees for the fiscal year of 2014/2015. The device fees for previous years were discussed at previous hearings.

The division will entertain any comments and/or questions with respect to the proposed device fees. Specific questions about the central system which do not pertain to the fees will be addressed following the public hearing.
