INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

HCR 90	FOIL	CONSTITUTION/CONVENTION Creates a commission to study the feasibility of a constitutional convention and make recommendations relative thereto
HB 31	RICHARD	LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS (Constitutional Amendment) Removes ability for the legislature to opt out of a veto session
HB 32	RICHARD	GOVERNOR/POWERS-VETO (Constitutional Amendment) Removes governor's authority to veto line items in an appropriation bill
HB 398	PRICE I	INTERIM EMERGENCY BOARD Changes requirements for approval of capital outlay priority changes and project descriptions
HB 559	MORRIS, JAY	FISCAL CONTROLS Requires certain contracting entities to submit information to the legislative auditor prior to contracting with a state agency or receiving state monies
HB 650	STOKES	INTERIM EMERGENCY BOARD Changes notification procedures and changes balloting procedures for approval of capital outlay priority changes and project descriptions
HB 237	SMITH, P.	REGISTRARS OF VOTERS (Constitutional Amendment) Requires the registrar of voters in each parish to be appointed for a term and authorizes the manner of appointment of the registrar to be provided by law
HB 452	SMITH, P.	REGISTRARS OF VOTERS Provides relative to registrars of voters and certain employees of the registrar
HB 651	GAINES	VOTERS/VOTING Provides for automatic voter registration through driver's license facilities
HCR 77	JACKSON	CONGRESS Memorializes congress to amend and reenact Section 4 of the Voting Rights Act
HB 246	HENSGENS	ETHICS Provides relative to certain prohibited conflicts for members of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education and the superintendent of education
HB 626	IVEY	ETHICS Provides relative to conflicts of interest for members of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education and the Superintendent of Education
HB 610	HARRIS	STATE AGENCIES Places the Department of Economic Development within the office of the lieutenant governor
HB 368	BADON	FAMILY VIOLENCE Establishes family justice centers to assist victims of certain offenses
HB 600	GEYMANN	ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE Provides relative to the Administrative Procedure Act
HB 137	HAVARD	PRIVATIZATION Creates the Privatization Review Act
