<b>HB 961</b>	<b>CROMER</b>	<b>DRUGS/PRESCRIPTION</b> Requires educational or marketing materials for prescription drugs directed to healthcare providers to include price information
<b>HB 979</b>	<b>MILLER, D.</b>	<b>NURSES</b> Provides relative to functions and composition of the La. State Board of Nursing
<b>HB 980</b>	<b>BROADWATER</b>	<b>MEDICAID</b> Provides relative to the medical assistance program of the state
<b>SB 33</b>	<b>GATTI</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Prohibits the harvest, collection, sale, or transport of organs or body parts of aborted babies. (8/1/16)
<b>SB 56</b>	<b>JOHNS</b>	<b>CONTROL DANGER SUBSTANCE</b> Provides for retention, archiving, and destruction of records in the state prescription monitoring program. (8/1/16)
<b>SB 187</b>	<b>BARROW</b>	<b>NURSES</b> Provides relative to advanced practice registered nursing. (gov sig)
<b>SB 189</b>	<b>JOHNS</b>	<b>PHARMACISTS</b> Provides for pharmacist dispensing exceptions. (gov sig)

<b>HB 283</b>	<b>EMERSON</b>	<b>CHILDREN/NEWBORNS</b> Requires screening of newborns for Krabbe disease
<b>SB 21</b>	<b>BOUDREAUX</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE</b> Extends legislative authority for the Louisiana Obesity Prevention and Management Commission. (8/1/16)
<b>SB 106</b>	<b>BOUDREAUX</b>	<b>VITAL STATISTICS</b> Specifies when a short-form birth certificate card may be purchased. (gov sig)
<b>SB 309</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE</b> Amends supervision requirements for certain addictive disorder practitioners in certain custodial environments. (8/1/16)
<b>SB 326</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Provides relative to reporting of child abuse and neglect. (8/1/16)
<b>SB 328</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE</b> Provides for telehealth access. (8/1/16)
<b>SB 376</b>	<b>COLOMB</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE</b> Creates the Louisiana Family Caregiver Act. (8/1/16)
<b>SCR 4</b>	<b>BARROW</b>	<b>HEALTH SERVICES</b> Continues the task force to study and make recommendations concerning health services delivery and financing in the Baton Rouge region.
<b>SCR 11</b>	<b>BOUDREAUX</b>	<b>VITAL STATISTICS</b> Directs the Department of Health and Hospitals to evaluate and report on increasing access to vital records at parish health units.
<b>SCR 14</b>	<b>BISHOP, W.</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE</b> Requests the New Orleans East Hospital to become a Diabetes Education and Research Center.
