RE: SENATE BILL NO. 1440 BY SENATORS JONES AND LANDRY

To enact R.S. 32:410(D), relative to drivers' licenses; to prohibit use of photographs taken for licenses in police line-ups; to provide for exemptions to prohibition; and to provide for related matters.

Dear Mr. Baer:

Senate Bill No. 1440 would establish an unacceptable limitation on the use of driver's license photographs insofar as it would not allow such unless the applicant had given permission or actually was a suspect for which the line-up is conducted. For this reason, I am vetoing Senate Bill No. 1440 and returning it to you.
