RE: SENATE BILL NO. 1019 BY SENATOR HOLLIS

To amend and reenact R.S. 17:1681.1(A), and to enact R.S. 33:2201(E), relative to benefits for certain law enforcement officers; to provide certain benefits to enforcement officers or their survivors; and to provide for related matters.

Dear Mr. Baer:

The object of Senate Bill No. 1019 was to expand certain benefits for police officers and deputy sheriffs killed or disabled under certain circumstances. After passage, technical concerns about the effect of the bill deemed valid by the author lead him to request its veto to avoid unintended consequences and allow time for preparation of a new bill for adoption at the next appropriate legislative session.

For this reason, I am vetoing and returning Senate Bill No. 1019 to you.
