44 of a cooperative agreement from the Office of Facility Planning and Control, and  
45 may be used to acquire land or real property, the title to which is held in the  
46 name of an entity exempt from taxation under the provisions of 26 U.S.C.  
47 501(c)(3). Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay  
48 Act to the contrary or any other provision of law, all of the funds herein  
49 appropriated to the Department of Economic Development in connection with  
50 the Capital Improvements Project to Meet Economic Development Commitments  
51 for which the Department of Economic Development utilizes a cooperative  
52 endeavor agreement to further economic development as permitted under Article  
53 VII, Section 14 of the Louisiana Constitution, including the generation of tax

34 and ancillary equipment that exceed the customary ten percent limitation on

36 to the contrary or any other provision of law, contracts may be entered into for  
37 the Greater Baton Rouge Port Commission Inland River Marine Terminal Dock  
38 and Access Roadway Construction Project, Planning and Construction Project  
39 prior to receipt of funding and prior to the execution of a cooperative endeavor  
40 agreement. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary or any other  
41 provision of law, monies appropriated herein for the Juban Road (LA1026)  
42 Widening (I-12 to US 190) project may be expended for the installation of sewer  
43 lines along the roadway and pursuant to a cooperative endeavor agreement  
44 between the Department of Transportation and Development and Livingston

12 Louisiana, Planning and Construction project, the Louisiana Stadium and  
13 Exposition District shall be permitted to use alternative competitive procurement  
14 and delivery methods for the award of any contracts to be funded through such  
15 appropriation. The Louisiana Stadium and Exposition District shall have the  
16 authority to directly appoint the design professional from a list of a minimum of  
17 three architectural firms or joint ventures with professional sports facility design  
18 experience acceptable to the Commissioner of Administration and shall be  
19 exempt from other state requirements for selection of designers. The design  
20 professional fee shall be in accordance with state guidelines administered by the  
21 Office of Facility Planning and Control, Division of Administration. Eligible  
22 expenses for Economic Development Award Program funds may include  
23 documented project expenses beginning on the date of LEDC Board approval of  
24 the project and may be reimbursed upon execution of the cooperative endeavor  
25 agreement for the project. The new University Medical Center in New Orleans  
26 project in Orleans Parish shall be exempt from the state's requirements for  
27 selection of designers and the Commissioner of Administration shall have the  
28 authority to approve a design professional selection process. The design  
29 professional fee shall be in accordance with state guidelines administered by the  
30 Office of Facility Planning and Control, Division of Administration. The  
31 Division of Administration, Office of Facility Planning and Control, with  
32 approval of the Commissioner of Administration and the Joint Legislative  
33 Committee on the Budget, is authorized to use alternative delivery strategies in  
34 implementing hurricane damage repairs to Southern University at New Orleans,  
35 Hazardous Material Abatement Projects, the City Park Golf Complex  
36 Improvements project, the Health/Human Performance Education Complex, and  
37 the Patrick Taylor Hall Renovation and Expansion project. In addition, with the  
38 approval of the Commissioner of Administration and the Joint Legislative  
39 Committee on the Budget, an alternative delivery strategy may be used in the  
40 implementation of the Louisiana Children's Museum, Early Learning Village  
41 project. Due to the State's current investment in TPC Louisiana and the financial  
42 support it provides to the PGA TOUR event currently played at said facility, the  
43 funding of the City Park Golf Complex Improvements project described above  
44 is conditioned upon said PGA TOUR event not being played at New Orleans  
45 City Park Golf Complex without the prior agreement of the Commissioner of  
46 Administration and the Chairman of the Jefferson Parish Council.  
47 Notwithstanding the foregoing, the City Park Golf Complex may host any other  
48 golf tournament or event, including but not limited to any other PGA-affiliated  
49 or sponsored tournament or event. For all projects administered by the Office of  
50 Facility Planning and Control and payable from proceeds of self-generated  
51 revenues, funds shall be remitted to the Office of Facility Planning and Control  
52 for deposit in the state treasury at such time as may be deemed necessary by the  
53 Office of Facility Planning and Control in order to cover the amount of contracts  
54 or other project expenses. The State Treasurer shall refund to the appropriate  
55 source any surplus self-generated funds, advanced insurance funds received by  
56 the Office of Facility Planning and Control as Interagency Transfer from Office  
57 of Risk Management associated with hurricane damage recovery, and interest  
58 earned on these funds, provided the Treasurer's Office is notified, when these  
59 funds are deposited in the state treasury, that the user agency or Office of Risk

1 Management intends to request a refund of this interest. Any revenue bonds  
2 appropriated in Section 1 of the Capital Outlay Act shall not be secured by the  
3 full faith and credit of the state. Notwithstanding anything in this Act or the  
4 Capital Outlay Act to the contrary or any other provision of law, contracts may  
5 be entered into for the Mississippi River Levee Raising, Arkansas to Old River  
6 project prior to receipt of funding, and the State is authorized to financially  
7 participate in obligations created by such contracts. Notwithstanding anything  
8 in this Act to the contrary or any other provision of law, contracts may be entered  
9 into for the Deep Water Gulf Transfer Terminal Authority for Deep Water  
10 Terminal Transfer Engineering Fees, which project includes other necessary  
11 services ancillary or incidental to the capital outlay project as included or  
12 indicated in the capital outlay request for such project, prior to receipt of funding  
13 and prior to the execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement, and unless the  
14 Commissioner of Administration is advised by bond counsel to the state that such  
15 may violate federal tax law, the appropriation may be used to pay for such  
16 contracts and ancillary and incidental services prior to the granting of a line of  
17 credit or the sale of bonds by the State Bond Commission. Notwithstanding  
18 anything in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the contrary or any other  
19 provision of law, contracts may be entered into for the Old McKinley High  
20 School Community Center on Thomas Delpit Drive in the City of Baton Rouge,  
21 Kitchen and Building Renovations and Elevator Repair Project prior to receipt  
22 of funding and prior to the execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement, and  
23 unless the Commissioner of Administration is advised by bond counsel to the  
24 state that such may violate federal tax law, the appropriation may be used to  
25 reimburse any expenditure made prior to the granting of a line of credit or the  
26 sale of bonds by the State Bond Commission. Notwithstanding anything in this  
27 Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the contrary or any other provision of law,  
28 contracts may be entered into for the Tulane University Tulane River and Coastal  
29 Center Project prior to receipt of funding and prior to the execution of a  
30 cooperative endeavor agreement, and the project is exempted from all statutes  
31 relative to public bidding and state procurement and in lieu thereof shall be  
32 subject to federal government qualifications and regulations approved by the  
33 Economic Development Authority. Notwithstanding anything in this Act or the  
34 Capital Outlay Act to the contrary or any other provision of law, contracts may  
35 be entered into for the Outpatient Clinics in Rapides Parish, Planning and  
36 Construction project for the Division of Administration prior to the execution of  
37 a cooperative endeavor agreement. Notwithstanding anything in this Act or the  
38 Capital Outlay Act to the contrary or any other provision of law, contracts may  
39 be entered into for the Natural Gas Distribution System Rehabilitation and  
40 Improvement project for the Town of St. Francisville prior to the execution of a  
41 cooperative endeavor agreement. Notwithstanding any other provision of this  
42 Act or the Capital Outlay Act or any other provision of law to the contrary, funds  
43 appropriated for the Economic Development Award Program project for the  
44 Office of Business Development are to be used solely for capital and  
45 infrastructure improvements subject to verification by the Division of  
46 Administration, Office of Facility Planning and Control. Notwithstanding any  
47 other provision of this Act or the Capital Outlay Act or any other provision of  
48 law to the contrary, all of the funds herein appropriated to the Department of  
49 Economic Development in connection with projects or programs for which the  
50 Department of Economic Development utilizes a cooperative endeavor  
51 agreement to further economic development as permitted under Article VII,  
52 Section 14 of the Louisiana Constitution, including the generation of tax  
53 revenues and creation of jobs, shall be considered as having been appropriated  
54 to the Department of Economic Development, may be used to reimburse any  
55 expenditure made prior to the granting of a line of credit and made prior to the  
56 execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement and shall be administered solely  
57 by the Department of Economic Development pursuant to, in compliance with,  
58 and on the terms contained in such cooperative endeavor agreements without  
59 compliance with any other law, including, but not limited to, the provisions of

1 R.S. 39:101 through 128. Additionally, all expenditures of these appropriations  
 2 may be exempted by the Commissioner of Administration, from all statutes  
 3 relative to public bidding, contractual review and the provisions of R.S.  
 4 33:9029.2(D). Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital  
 5 Outlay Act, or any other provision of law to the contrary, the letting of a contract  
 6 for construction of the "Louisiana Construction Center", funded wholly by the  
 7 Louisiana Licensing Board for Contractors, shall be exempt from all statutes  
 8 relative to public bidding and contractual review. Notwithstanding anything  
 9 contained in this Act or any other provision of law to the contrary, contracts may  
 10 be entered into for The Global Foundation for Better Education, Health and  
 11 Environment, Inc. for the Urgent Care Facility, Planning and Construction  
 12 project prior to the issuance of a line of credit, prior to receipt of funding, and  
 13 prior to execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement and the project is  
 14 exempted from all statutes relative to public bidding, contractual review, and  
 15 review of plans and specifications by the Office of Facility Planning and Control.  
 16 Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act or any  
 17 other provision of law to the contrary, contracts may be entered into for the City  
 18 of Gretna's Lion's Club Conversion to Senior Center project prior to receipt of  
 19 funding and prior to execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement and the  
 20 project is exempted from all statutes relative to public bidding and contractual  
 21 review. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital Outlay Act,  
 22 or any other provision of law to the contrary, the scope of the appropriation for  
 23 Division of Administration, Shreveport State Office Building Mechanical and  
 24 Electrical Renovations (Caddo) is deemed to also include a study of the  
 25 feasibility of consolidating state office space in Shreveport into a central  
 26 downtown location in accordance with HCR 202 of 2009. Notwithstanding  
 27 anything contained in this Act, the Capital Outlay Act, or any other provision of  
 28 law to the contrary, \$8,500,000 of in expenditures from the appropriation for  
 29 Louisiana Stadium and Exposition District, Professional Sports Facilities,  
 30 Planning and Construction and Leasehold Improvements shall be consistent with  
 31 the deliverables as enumerated in the Arena Use Agreement and Project  
 32 Development agreement. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the  
 33 Capital Outlay Act, or any other provision of law to the contrary, the Department  
 34 of Transportation and Development shall use \$2,500,000 of general obligation  
 35 bond funding appropriated for Department of Transportation and Development,  
 36 Administration, Highway Program (Up to \$4,000,000 for Secretary's Emergency  
 37 Fund) in Act 25 of the 2014 Regular Session of the Legislature for the Louisiana  
 38 Highway 92 Overlay, Preservation and Construction (Lafayette) project.  
 39 Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital Outlay Act, or any  
 40 other provision of law to the contrary, \$50,000 of the appropriation for  
 41 Department of Natural Resources, Office of the Secretary, Atchafalaya Basin  
 42 Protection and Enhancement (Federal Match and Local/Sponsor  
 43 Match)(Assumption, Avoyelles, Iberia, Iberville, Pointe Coupee, St. Landry, St.  
 44 Martin, St. Mary) will be used to fund House Concurrent Resolution No. 168 of  
 45 2011. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital Outlay Act,  
 46 or any other provision of law to the contrary, the scope of the appropriation for  
 47 LSU Health Sciences Center Health Care Services Division, University Medical  
 48 Center in Baton Rouge (East Baton Rouge) is deemed to also include the  
 49 demolition of the Earl K. Long Hospital facility in Baton Rouge and up to  
 50 \$2,000,000 of the appropriation shall be used to pay the costs of demolishing the  
 51 Earl K. Long Hospital facility. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act  
 52 or the Capital Outlay Act to the contrary, any other provisions of law, or the  
 53 provisions of R.S. 39:112(E)(2), the project for Eden House, New Facility,  
 54 Acquisition, Planning and Construction, shall be exempt from all local match  
 55 requirements. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital  
 56 Outlay Act, or any other Capital Outlay Act, the scope of the appropriation in  
 57 Act 2 of the 2004 R.S. for the Morgan City Harbor and Terminal District,



1 Atchafalaya River, Bayou Chene, Bayou Boeuf, and Bayou Black Deepening  
 2 Project Feasibility Study project in St. Mary Parish shall include additional  
 3 navigable depth surveys, survey interpretation, and updates to prior related work.  
 4 Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital Outlay Act, or any  
 5 other Capital Outlay Act, the scope of the appropriation for the Port of Lake  
 6 Charles Highway 397 in Calcasieu Parish, North and South Turning Lanes and  
 7 Rail Spur at Farmers Rice Mill, Planning and Construction (Calcasieu) project  
 8 shall be deemed to include installation of a traffic warning system at the train  
 9 crossing on LA 397. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital  
 10 Outlay Act, or any other Capital Outlay Act, the scope of the appropriation for  
 11 the Department of Transportation and Development, Bundicks Lake Level  
 12 Control Structure, Planning and Construction project in Beauregard Parish shall  
 13 be deemed to include repairs."
