Boudreaux

Prior law provided that the governor appoint members of the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners when a vacancy occurs for any reason including expiration of term, removal, resignation, death, disability, or disqualification in the same manner as the original appointment.

Prior law required that members of the board be appointed for a term of four years, beginning on July first in the year in which the appointment is made, unless the member is appointed to fill an unfinished term of his predecessor.

New law provides that no member shall serve more than three consecutive terms.

Effective upon signature of the governor (June 12, 2017).
