

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

**ACT 117 (HB 19)**

**2017 Regular Session**

**Magee**

Existing law provides that the maximum penalty that may be imposed for the violation of a parish ordinance is a \$500 fine and imprisonment of 30 days in parish jail. Provides that the maximum length of imprisonment in Jefferson Parish is six months and authorizes higher penalties for violations of certain ordinances in East Baton Rouge and Jefferson. Authorizes imposition of civil penalties for some violations of waste treatment ordinances.

New law authorizes imposition of up to 100 hours of community service, in addition to or in lieu of penalties authorized by existing law, for a violation of a parish ordinance.

Effective August 1, 2017.
