Abstract: Authorizes a public entity to reject the lowest bid from a bidder who engages in a boycott, divestment, or sanctions campaign against Israel.

Present law provides for the methods and requirements of procurement that a state entity must use for contracts and purchases under the Procurement Code.

Proposed law retains present law but authorizes a public entity to reject the lowest bid from a vendor who engages in a boycott, divestment, or sanctions campaign against Israel. Further authorizes a public entity to terminate a contract with a vendor who engages in a boycott, divestment, or sanctions campaign against Israel during the duration of the contract.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
