 Requires the Evangeline Parish Tax Assessor to pay the cost of certain insurance premiums for eligible retirees from the assessor's office

**Purpose of Bill:** This bill requires the Evangeline Parish Assessor to pay certain group insurance premiums for certain retirees and is putting current practice in to law. The bill applies to retirees employed before August 1, 2014 with at least 20 years of service and retirees hired on or after August 1, 2014 with at least 20 years of service (of which 12 years must be with the Evangeline Parish Assessor).
