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Provides for responsibilities of law enforcement officers while interacting with the public. (8/1/21)

Proposed legislation requires law enforcement agencies that use body cameras to adopt a policy regarding the activation and deactivation of the camera by January 1, 2022. Proposed legislation prohibits the use of choke holds and carotid holds and no-knock warrants, except under specific circumstances enumerated in the legislation.

Effective August 1, 2021.
