ACT 147 (HB 60)

Brass

Existing law establishes the Dual Enrollment Framework Task Force to make recommendations for a statewide dual enrollment framework to provide universal access to dual enrollment courses. Requires local public school boards to develop agreements with colleges and universities for articulation and transfer of credit.

Prior law provided for task force termination on June 30, 2021. New law repeals prior law. Further provides that the task force is responsible for implementing the dual enrollment framework.

Prior law required the Bd. of Regents to submit a written report of task force findings and recommendations to the legislative committees on education by Oct. 1, 2020. New law requires annual submission of such a report.

New law adds one member to the task force, a secondary school teacher who teaches a dual enrollment course.

Effective August 1, 2021.
