SB 40 Original

McMath

Present law provides for the Protect and Save our Children Program for issuance of special identification cards for persons under the age of 16 years old. Present law further provides that the card will be issued without cost to a foster child.

Proposed law retains present law and requires that a person providing foster care services shall obtain one of the following no later than 90 days after the placement of the child in the foster home:

- (1) A special identification card issued for the child.
- (2) If the child does not qualify for a special identification card, a photograph of the child.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
