Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to Original Senate Bill No. 347 by Senator Milligan

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 38:2237.1(D)" delete the remainder of the line and insert "and
3 R.S. 39:1672(C)(2) and 1753(A)(1) and (E), and to enact R.S. 39:1672(C)(7), relative to"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 4, after "vendors;" insert "to provide for definitions;"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, at the end of line 6 and the beginning of line 7, delete "and R.S. 38:2237.1(E)
8 is hereby enacted"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 1, line 9 delete "state"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 5

12 On page 1, delete lines 11 through 17 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 5, and insert the
13 following:

15 1, 2021, by state agencies, ~~certain educational entities, and their service providers.~~
16 **Any vendor or other entity who provides the documentation required in**

25 Section 2. R.S. 39:1672(C)(2) and R.S. 39:1753.1(A)(1) and (E) are hereby amended
26 and reenacted, and R. S. 39:1672(C)(7) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

39 §1753.1 Procurement of telecommunications or video surveillance equipment
40 or services by ~~state~~ agencies and certain educational entities

1 (1) "Agency" shall have the same meaning as provided in R.S. 36:3 means
 2 any department, office, division, commission, council, board, bureau,
 3 committee, institution, agency, government corporation, or other establishment
 4 or official of the executive branch of state government or any parish, city, town,
 5 governmental body, and any other subdivision of the state or public agency
 6 thereof, public authority, public educational, health, or other institution, and
 7 to the extent provided by law, any other entity which expends public funds for
 8 the acquisition or leasing of supplies, services, major repairs, and construction.

10 E. This Section shall apply only to procurements initiated on or after August
