Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Engrossed House Bill No. 196 by Representative Nelson

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**1** AMENDMENT NO. 1**2** On page 1, at the beginning of line 5, delete "public" and insert "certain"**3** AMENDMENT NO. 2**4** On page 2, at the end of line 2, delete the period "." and insert "and institutions that are  
**5** members of the Louisiana Association of Independent Colleges and Universities."**6** AMENDMENT NO. 3**7** On page 2, at the beginning of line 20, change "(2)" to "(2)(a)"**8** AMENDMENT NO. 4**9** On page 2, between lines 22 and 23, insert the following:**10** "(b) The board shall award grants such that the percentage of all  
**11** grant amounts in a year that is awarded to historically black colleges and  
**12** universities is approximately equal to the percentage of all students enrolled  
**13** in postsecondary education institutions who are enrolled at historically black  
**14** colleges and universities."**15** AMENDMENT NO. 5**16** On page 3, line 1, after "(2)" and before "July 1," delete "Beginning" and insert in lieu  
**17** thereof "On"**18** AMENDMENT NO. 6**19** On page 3, line 3, after "SMART fund" delete the remainder of the line in its entirety and  
**20** insert a period "." and insert the following:**21** "Each July first thereafter the treasurer is authorized and directed to  
**22** transfer from the state general fund into the fund an amount sufficient to  
**23** bring the balance of the fund up to one hundred fifty million dollars."**24** AMENDMENT NO. 7**25** On page 3, after line 19, insert the following:**26** "Section 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall become effective when an  
**27** Act of the Louisiana Legislature containing a specific appropriation of monies for the  
**28** implementation of the provisions of this Act becomes effective.**29** Section 3. The provisions of Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall become effective  
**30** upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time  
**31** for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section  
**32** 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved  
**33** by the legislature, the provisions of Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall become effective on  
**34** the day following such approval."
