2 On page 1, line 2, after "and" and before "to enact" insert "1379.5(A) and"

6 On page 1, line 4, after "R.S. 40:2402(3)(f)," and before "relative" insert "and to repeal
7 Subpart E of Part VII of Chapter 1 of Title 49 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,
8 comprised of R.S. 49:149 through 149.5,"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 1, line 10, after "definitions;" insert "to provide relative to jurisdiction; to remove
11 provisions for the capitol police;"

13 On page 1, line 13, after "693" insert a comma ","

14 AMENDMENT NO. 6

15 On page 2, line 26, after "security" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 27 and
16 28 and insert "**for the areas within the state capitol complex, as defined in R.S.
17 40:1379.5, that are occupied and utilized by the members, officers, and staff of
18 legislative branch of state government, including areas of ingress and egress for those
19 areas as necessary.**"

23 On page 3, line 2, after "committees" delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning
24 of line 3, delete "of Representatives"

26 On page 3, line 9, after "security" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 10 and
27 11 and insert "**for the areas within the state capitol complex, as defined in R.S.
28 40:1379.5, that are occupied and utilized by the members, officers, and staff of
29 legislative branch of state government, including areas of ingress and egress for those
30 areas as necessary.**"

1 AMENDMENT NO. 10

2 On page 4, line 1, after "**security plan**" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 2
3 and 3 and insert "**for the areas within the state capitol complex, as defined in R.S.**
4 **40:1379.5, that are occupied and utilized by the members, officers, and staff of**
5 **legislative branch of state government.**"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 11

7 On page 4, line 22, after "**building**" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 23 and
8 insert "**and other areas within the state capitol complex, as defined in R.S. 40:1379.5,**
9 **that are occupied and utilized by the members, officers, and staff of the legislative**
10 **branch of state government.**"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 12

12 On page 5, line 25, after "**security plan**" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 26
13 and insert "**for the areas within the state capitol complex, as defined in R.S. 40:1379.5,**
14 **that are occupied and utilized by the legislative branch of state government as it deems**
15 **necessary or**"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 13

17 On page 6, line 18, after "R.S. 40:1379.1(N)" delete "is" and insert "and 1379.5(A) are"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 14

19 On page 7, between lines 1 and 2, insert the following:

20 "§1379.5. State capitol complex; provision of police protection; maintenance of
21 peace and order

22 A.**(1)** The deputy secretary for public safety services of the Department of
23 Public Safety and Corrections shall provide that public safety services police officers
24 regularly patrol all areas within the state capitol complex to maintain peace and order
25 and to prevent and detect crime.

26 **(2) Within the areas in the state capitol complex that are occupied and**
27 **utilized by the members, officers, and staff of the legislative branch of state**
28 **government, all public safety services police officers shall coordinate with and**
29 **be subject to the direction of the director of capitol security in accordance with**
30 **Chapter 12 of Title 24 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.**

32 AMENDMENT NO. 15

33 On page 7, between lines 9 and 10, insert the following:

34 "Section 3. Subpart E of Part VII of Chapter 1 of Title 49 of the Louisiana
35 Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 49:149 through 149.5, is hereby
36 repealed in its entirety.

37 Section 4. Notwithstanding any provision of Section 1 of this Act to the
38 contrary, the presiding officer of each house of the legislature shall make the initial
39 appointments to the Capitol Security Council and the council shall hold its first
40 meeting within ninety days after the effective date of this Act."
