Amendments proposed by Senator White to Reengrossed House Bill No. 406 by Representative Zeringue

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete Amendments No. 2, 3, 8, 14, and 15 proposed by the Senate Committee on Finance  
3 and adopted by the Senate on May 15, 2022.

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 In Senate Committee Amendment No. 11, proposed by the Senate Committee on Finance  
6 and adopted by the Senate on May 15, 2022, on page 2, at the end of line 3, delete the  
7 quotation mark "" and insert the following:

9       "(X) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is  
10 hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$6,867,514 from the State General Fund (Direct)  
11 to the Emergency Communications Interoperability Fund, contingent upon the Act that  
12 originated as House Bill No. 1070 of this 2022 Regular Session of the Legislature becoming  
13 law.

14       (Y) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is hereby  
15 authorized and directed to transfer \$10,000,000 from the State General Fund (Direct) to the  
16 Major Events Incentive Fund, contingent upon the Act which originated as House Bill No.  
17 1015 of this 2022 Regular Session of the Legislature becoming law.

18       (Z) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is hereby  
19 authorized and directed to transfer \$5,000,000 from the State General Fund (Direct) to the  
20 Events Incentive Fund, contingent upon the Act which originated as House Bill No. 1015  
21 of this 2022 Regular Session of the Legislature becoming law.

22       (AA) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is  
23 hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$130,000,000 from the State General Fund  
24 (Direct) to the Capital Outlay Savings Fund.""

9 SUBPART Q-2. CONSTRUCTION SUBFUND PRESERVATION ACCOUNT  
10 §100.123. Construction Subfund Preservation Account

11 A. There is hereby established in the state treasury an account within the  
12 Construction Subfund of the Transportation Trust Fund the Construction Subfund  
13 Preservation Account, hereafter referred to in this Section as the "Preservation  
14 Account". Monies appropriated or transferred to the Preservation Account shall be  
15 deposited by the state treasurer after compliance with the provisions of Article VII,  
16 Section 9(B) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

17 B. Monies in the Preservation Account shall be invested by the treasurer in  
18 the same manner as state general fund monies. Interest earned on monies in the  
19 Preservation Account shall be credited to the Preservation Account. Unexpended  
20 and unencumbered monies in the Preservation Account at the end of the fiscal year  
21 shall remain in the Preservation Account to which they are credited.

22 C. Monies in the Preservation Account shall be used by the Department of  
23 Transportation and Development solely for the direct costs associated with actual  
24 project delivery, construction, and maintenance of highway and bridge preservation  
25 projects approved by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget."

39 deposited in the fund from this transfer shall be immediately transferred as follows:  
40 \$100,000,000 to the Construction Subfund Preservation Account as established in this Act  
41 and \$500,000,000 to the following Megaprojects Leverage Fund accounts contingent upon  
42 the Act that originated as Senate Bill No. 277 of the 2022 Regular Session of the Louisiana  
43 Legislature becoming law: \$300,000,000 to the Mississippi River Bridge at Baton Rouge and  
44 Connections Account, \$100,000,000 to the I-49 South Leverage Fund Account, and  
45 \$100,000,000 to the I-10 Calcasieu River Bridge and I-10 Improvements Account."

11 "Monies in the fund shall be used to make full or partial payments to political  
12 subdivisions, including school boards, that suffered property loss or damage caused  
13 by Hurricane Ida and were not fully compensated for such property loss or damage  
14 by insurance and other federal and state disaster resources. Any payment to a  
15 political subdivision made from the fund pursuant to the provisions of this Section  
16 shall be applied by the governing authority of the political subdivision to the cost of  
17 repair or replacement of the damaged property."

18 AMENDMENT NO. 16

19 On page 9, between lines 24 and 25, insert the following:

20 "C. Up to three percent of monies initially deposited into the fund may be  
21 retained by the treasurer for administrative expenses. Subject to final approval of the  
22 Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget prior to implementation, the treasurer is  
23 hereby authorized and directed to develop policies and procedures for the  
24 distribution and administration of monies in the fund. Notwithstanding any  
25 provision of law to the contrary, the treasurer may enter into consulting services,  
26 professional services, and information and technology services contracts for the  
27 purpose of the procurement of any goods or services necessary to implement and  
28 expedite the distribution of monies in the fund as emergency procurements exempt  
29 from the provisions of the Louisiana Procurement Code and corresponding rules and  
30 regulations. The cost of such contracts shall be an administrative expense of the  
31 recovery program."

32 AMENDMENT NO. 17

33 On page 10, between lines 11 and 12, insert the following:

34 "SUBPART X. FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 LOUISIANA TOURISM REVIVAL  
35 FUND

36 §100.191. Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Louisiana Tourism Revival Fund

37 A. There is hereby created in the state treasury, as a special fund, the Fiscal Year  
38 2022-2023 Louisiana Tourism Revival Fund, hereinafter referred to in this Section as the  
39 "fund". The fund shall consist of any monies appropriated, allocated, or transferred to the  
40 fund.

41 B. All unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund at the end of the fiscal year  
42 shall remain in the fund. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies  
43 in the state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of monies in the fund shall be  
44 deposited in and credited to the fund.

1           C. Monies in the fund shall be utilized to provide grants to local and regional tourist  
2 commissions for marketing and promoting Louisiana as a tourism destination for in-state and  
3 out-of-state travel activity. In order to qualify to receive a grant award, the recipient shall be  
4 an official tourism commission, convention and visitors bureau, or official destination  
5 marketing organization.

6           D. Monies in the fund shall be administered by the division of administration in the  
7 same manner as provided for R.S. 39:100.55."
