2 WHEREAS, the citizens of Louisiana struggle daily to survive in this harsh  
3 economic environment; and

4 WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the leadership of this state to assist its citizens  
5 whenever and wherever possible.

6 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana hereby suspends  
7 all existing statutory and regulatory provisions, rules, or internal policies relative to  
8 mandatory or continuing education courses or training requirements imposed either as a  
9 prerequisite to the issuance, maintenance, recertification or renewal of an occupational or  
10 professional license for occupations and professions within the state, whereby the participant  
11 is required to pay for such courses or training, except for mandatory continuing legal  
12 education administered through the Louisiana Supreme Court by the Mandatory Continuing  
13 Legal Education Committee.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this suspension shall become effective upon  
15 adoption of this Resolution and shall extend through the sixtieth day after final adjournment  
16 of the 2011 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.

#### DIGEST

Suspends all provisions relative to continuing education training requirements imposed on occupations and professions within the state. Exempts MCLE for attorneys from the provisions of the Resolution.

Effective upon adoption through the 60<sup>th</sup> day following the 2011 R.S.
