

New law requires any bid submitted by, or a contract or cooperative endeavor agreement with, a dealer include a copy of a valid state dealer's license issued by the La. Motor Vehicle Commission. A public entity shall not contract with the dealer that does not possess a valid state license.

New law provides that if, in the course of an audit or review by the legislative auditor, a violation of new law is found, the legislative auditor shall report such findings to the La. Motor Vehicle Commission.

New law defines "public entity" as any agency, board, commission, department, or public corporation of the state, created by the constitution or statute or pursuant thereto, or any political subdivision of the state, including port commissions and districts, and any public housing authority, public school board, or any public officer.
