| SB | 244 | ADLEY | FUNDS/FUNDING | Increases the available monies expended from the Motor Fuel Underground Storage Tank Trust Fund from one million dollars to one million five hundred thousand dollars. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 255 | MORRELL | POSTSECONDARY ED | Provides relative to sexual assault on college campuses. (gov sig) |
| SB | 257 | THOMPSON, F | SPECIAL DISTRICTS | Authorizes certain additional tax increment finance authority for certain Tax Increment Development Corporations. (gov sig) |
| SB | 260 | BROOME | GROUP BENEFITS PROGRAM | Provides for the organization of the Office of Group Benefits. (1/1/16) |
| SB | 269 | ADLEY | TAX/TAXATION | Requires corporations subject to Louisiana income or franchise tax which have either corporate gross revenues everywhere of \$8 billion or \$8 million of assets everywhere to file combined returns and limits their NOL deduction to 50% of tax liability. (gov sig) |
| SB | 271 | WHITE | TAX/TAXATION | Provides for equivalency of the special fuels tax with the gasoline tax on motor vehicles that operate on the highways using liquefied natural gas, liquefied petroleum gas, or compressed natural gas. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 272 | ERDEY | TAX/SALES | Exempts from local sales tax prosthetic devices prescribed by physicians for personal consumption or use, when the patient is covered by Medicaid or a Medicaid program administered by a third party on behalf of the state. (7/1/15) |

Provides for the practice of chiropractic. (gov sig)
- SB 61 BUFFINGTON HEALTH SERVICES
Provides relative to hospital service districts. (gov sig)
- SB 87 PERRY ETHICS
Removes financial disclosure requirements for members of boards and commissions that do not earn compensation or per diem. (8/1/15)
- SB 146 CLAITOR FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides relative to the Budget Stabilization Fund. (See Act)
- SB 167 BUFFINGTON MEDICAID
Provides relative to the Medical Assistance Program. (8/1/15)
- SB 177 ADLEY TAX/AD VALOREM
Constitutional amendment to add certain property tax exemptions and reductions and to provide with respect to tax credits associated with them; to dedicate the net state revenue increase to a Tax Credit Reduction Fund and provide for allocations from the fund; and to provide for appropriations to local tax authorities. (2/3-CA 13sl(A))
- SB 181 ADLEY TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Repeals an income tax deduction for the net capital gains on the sale of a nonpublicly traded business commercially domiciled in Louisiana. (gov sig)
- SB 217 GALLOT PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS
Authorizes the transfer of certain state property in Rapides Parish. (8/1/15)
- SB 218 MURRAY FUNDS/FUNDING
Establishes a program to attract major events to the state and dedicates funds therefor. (7/1/15)
- SB 234 DONAHUE TAX/TAXATION
Makes certain food businesses and any retail business except grocery stores and pharmacies with a certain number of employees ineligible for Enterprise Zone contracts. (gov sig)
- SB 240 LAFLEUR PUBLIC LANDS
Provides for the exchange of school lands by the Avoyelles Parish School Board. (gov sig)
