<u>Present law</u> provides vehicles driven at a speed of 10 miles per hour less than the posted speed limit in the left lane, other than for practicable purposes, are fined \$100 or less, or no more than 30 days imprisonment, or both.

Proposed law removes the 10 miles per hour or less parameter for the purposes of punishment.

<u>Proposed law</u> further changes the fine from \$100 or less to a first offense of \$150, second offense of \$250, and third offense of \$350. Proposed law further allows imprisonment of up to 30 days for a third subsequent offense within a 12 month period of the first offense or imprisonment up to 30 days, or both.

Effective August 1, 2025.
