SB 109 Original 2025 Regular Session Seabaugh

Present constitution does not address foreign donations in elections.

Proposed constitutional amendment would prohibit any funds, goods, or services, donated by a foreign government, foreign entity, or noncitizen from being used to promote any ballot initiative, candidate, issue, political party, or proposition, either directly or indirectly.

Specifies submission of the amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held on November 15, 2025.
