<u>Present law</u> provides for privately owned motor vehicles belonging to members of the emergency medical team to be equipped with a large flashing red light which shall have sufficient intensity to be visible at five hundred feet in normal sunlight.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides for privately owned motor vehicles belonging to general trauma surgeons licensed by the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners and actively practicing medicine in this state at a Level I trauma center to be equipped with emergency visual signals when en route to a medical emergency. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the office of public safety to develop a procedure and approval protocol for the use of the emergency equipment.
