HOUSE BILL NO. 614

BY REPRESENTATIVE CHASSION

Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

STUDENT/ASSESSMENT: Requires students to attain a minimum ACT score set by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education as a prerequisite to high school graduation and prohibits state-administered end-of-course assessments for high school students

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 17:24.4(F)(1)(k), relative to high school graduation requirements; to prohibit  
3 state-administered end-of-course assessments for high school students; to require  
4 students to attain a minimum score on a certain national norm-referenced test as a  
5 prerequisite to graduation; to require the State Board of Elementary and Secondary  
6 Education set such score by rule such that it does not lower the high school  
7 graduation rate; and to provide for related matters.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 17:24.4(F)(1)(k) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

10 §24.4. Louisiana Competency-Based Education Program; statewide standards for  
11 required subjects; Louisiana Educational Assessment Program; parish or city  
12 school board comprehensive pupil progression plans; waivers

16 (k) Notwithstanding any provision of this Section to the contrary, there shall  
17 be no state-administered end-of-course assessments for high school students. As a  
18 prerequisite to graduation, a student shall attain a certain minimum composite score
